The Weather

The High yesterday 64° The Low this morning 29°

Today: Sunny skies with a high near 62° and the calm wind shifts to easterly at around 5 mph.

Tonight: Overnight it will shift on around to S-SE at 5 mph and the low should be about 34° .

Thursday: Sunny and nice with a high near 62° and the S-SW wind at 5-15 mph. Overnight a small rain chance comes into the forecast mix.

Rest of the week: Friday will bring a cloudy day with a 20% chance of rain and more 60-ish temperatures. Friday night the rain chances increase and on Saturday the best chance of rain comes with a 40% probability. Saturday will otherwise be cloudy and up to 68° in the afternoon. However, the wind will shift and go back to northerly. The weak cool front will take out Sunday high down to low 60s and that should be with us into the early part of next week.
