# The Weather

### The High yesterday was $27^{\circ}$ The Low this morning $18^{\circ}$

**There was no measurable snow** accumulation at the airport on Tuesday, but there was light snow off and on all morning in Lampasas and out in the county.

**Today:** Sunshine at last! It should be considerably warmer today with a 53° high, almost twice yesterday's high temperature. That, in spite of the fact that the NW wind was still very stiff and cold this morning.

**Tonight:** The wind will finally calm as it readies for a shift to southerly on Thursday. Partly cloudy overnight with a light freeze again, down to  $26^{\circ}$ .

**Thursday:** Partly sunny with a high to 47° in the afternoon with the calm wind turning SE around 5 mph. Overnight it will get down to 29°, which seems modest compared to the past several days.

**Rest of the week:** Friday will bring a little sunshine and a high up to 55° and a decent day with southerly breezes. On Saturday and Sunday we'll have warm afternoons and south winds but there is a 20% chance of rain, and more unpleasant wind coming out of the south at 10-15-20, and up to 35 mph gusts.

#### Who Can Attend:

You must be at least 18 years of age, reside, own a business, or work in the City of Lampasas area and be willing to commit to 12 weeks of training

You must successfully complete a background check and not have outstanding warrants or have any felony convictions or be under indictment for one. There are also prohibitions for sexual related offenses, family violence or other past problems. #### Classes:

This will be our first Citizens' Police Academy and the Academy will be offered one time a year with a limit of 25 persons per Academy.

All instructors will be sworn police officers, personnel of the department, and guest speakers with expertise in their field. 


