## The Weather

The High yesterday was 27° The Low this morning 18°

There was no measurable snow accumulation at the airport on Tuesday, but there was light snow off and on all morning in Lampasas and out in the county.

**Today:** Sunshine at last! It should be considerably warmer today with a 53° high, almost twice yesterday's high temperature. That, in spite of the fact that the NW wind was still very stiff and cold this morning.

**Tonight:** The wind will finally calm as it readies for a shift to southerly on Thursday. Partly cloudy overnight with a light freeze again, down to 26°.

**Thursday:** Partly sunny with a high to 47° in the afternoon with the calm wind turning SE around 5 mph. Overnight it will get down to 29°, which seems modest compared to the past several days.

**Rest of the week:** Friday will bring a little sunshine and a high up to 55° and a decent day with southerly breezes. On Saturday and Sunday we'll have warm afternoons and south winds but there is a 20% chance of rain, and more unpleasant wind coming out of the south at 10-15-20, and up to 35 mph gusts.

## Reminders:

**The Garbage collection is a day late.** Because of the holiday, if your usual trash day is Tuesday, they're picking it up today. Likewise, every day this week is a day behind with Friday's pickup on Saturday, when they finally catch up.

## Citizens' Police Academy to Begin Jan. 31<sup>st</sup>.

According to Lampasas Police Chief Sammy Bailey, the Department will have their first ever Citizens' Police Academy starting Jan. 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018. Classes will be held each Wednesday night for 12 weeks. Classes are to be from 6 to 8pm.



### What is a Citizens' Police Academy?

A group of citizens interested in learning more about how their police department operates and the challenges our city faces. "We hope," Chief Sammy says, "that graduates will be more aware and informed about how our department operates and the challenges law enforcement face each day."

### Who Can Attend:

You must be at least 18 years of age, reside, own a business, or work in the City of Lampasas area and be willing to commit to 12 weeks of training

You must successfully complete a background check and not have outstanding warrants or have any felony convictions or be under indictment for one. There are also prohibitions for sexual related offenses, family violence or other past problems. ### Classes:

This will be our first Citizens' Police Academy and the Academy will be offered one time a year with a limit of 25 persons per Academy.

**These Classes are free** and members of the department will cover a variety of topics highlighting departmental units and duties. It will begin with an overview of the department and a tour of the facilities by Chief Bailey and Asst. Chief Cummings. All instructors will be sworn police officers, personnel of the department, and guest speakers with expertise in their field. Topics may include patrol procedures, street survival, DWI enforcement, narcotics, (Cont. on back)

## LCRA Offering Community Grants To Area Nonprofits, First Responders

Applications for new grants due by Jan. 31

The Lower Colorado River Authority is accepting applications for grants of up to \$50,000 for community projects in LCRA's wholesale electric or water service area.



Through 2017, LCRA and its wholesale electric customers have awarded 1,651 community grants totaling more than \$43 million. The grants help groups ranging from firefighters who need new breathing equipment to community centers that need new air conditioning units to parks that need new playscapes.

They are now accepting, through this month, applications from non-profits, volunteer fire depts. and first responders. Examples of eligible organizations include those mentioned above, as well as schools and local governments, libraries, civic groups, museums, etc.

For-profit entities, individuals, professional associations and nonprofits with limited group memberships are not eligible for the CDPP grants.

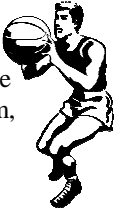
