The Weather



High yesterday was 56° The low this morning was 24°

Today: Partly sunny with a high near 54° and calm wind becoming SE around 5 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with isolated sprinkles, then clearing a little with a low around 33° overnight. The E-SE wind about 5 mph will turn calm by morning.

Friday: The calm wind will come up again to about 5-10 mph, but it will be a welcome breeze. The high will be up to about 60° in the afternoon with sunshine, before clouding up a little after dark and turning a little foggy before morning and dropping to 35° .

The weekend: The Saturday forecast is for morning fog, then partly sunny with light south wind and an afternoon high of 62° . There are chances of drizzle Saturday night and the south wind may gust a little.


