The Weather

High yesterday was 56° The low this morning was 24°

Today: Partly sunny with a high near 54° and calm wind becoming SE around 5 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with isolated sprinkles, then clearing a little with a low around 33° overnight. The E-SE wind about 5 mph will turn calm by morning.

Friday: The calm wind will come up again to about 5-10 mph, but it will be a welcome breeze. The high will be up to about 60° in the afternoon with sunshine, before clouding up a little after dark and turning a little foggy before morning and dropping to 35°.

The weekend: The Saturday forecast is for morning fog, then partly sunny with light south wind and an afternoon high of 62°. There are chances of drizzle Saturday night and the south wind may gust a little.

On Sunday there is a small rain chance, a high in the mid-60s and lots of south wind at 10-20-30 mph as the edge of the next front comes in. By Sunday night sometime the wind will shift to northerly and Monday we will see the likely weak cold front upon us for a day.

It should be in the 70s by Wednesday.

Notes:

The Garbage collection is still a day late. Because of the holiday, all garbage pickup is one day behind this week. It will be back to the normal pickup days next week.

Colorado Bend State Park is still closed to the public for Wildlife Management Activity until Friday. They will open back up to the public Friday afternoon at 2pm. For more info about the park, call (325) 628-3240.

The Lampasas County Youth Livestock Show is Jan. 11-13th, next Thursday through Saturday. All exhibitors are asked to show up at the barn **this Saturday, Jan. 6th**, to help clean up. The show will begin its first day on Thursday at 7am with the Rabbits. About noon day there will be the Food Fair, then the Broiler Show late in the afternoon at 6pm. All the while, other animals will be going through check-ins for the Friday events.
