## The Weather

High yesterday was  $54^{\circ}$  The low this morning was  $37^{\circ}$ 

**Today:** Partly sunny, then gradually sunny, with a high near  $61^{\circ}$  this afternoon. S-SW wind will be 5-10 mph.

**Tonight:** Patchy fog after 3am, otherwise mostly clear cloudy with a low around  $36^{\circ}$  and south wind 5 mph.

**Saturday:** Patchy fog in the morning, otherwise partly sunny with a high near  $62^{\circ}$  in the afternoon. The south wind will be 5-10 mph. In the evening the wind will rise up a bit more to 10-15 with gusts to 20. Overnight there is a chance of drizzle and a low of  $50^{\circ}$ .

**The weekend:** The Sunday forecast calls for a 20% chance of rain with possible thunderstorms in the afternoon. The high should be about  $65^{\circ}$  in the afternoon. The big Sunday story is wind, with the S-SW wind 15-20 mph and gusting as high as 30.

Sunday night the wind will continue but it will shift to N-NW with gusts to 20 mph.

Monday will be up to 61° for the high but the northerly wind will chill a bit. The wind will let up Monday night and shift back to southerly.

Tuesday will be a decent day and it could be near 70 by Wednesday.




