Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay reached out to Lampasas Radio yesterday evening to let us know it had been a rough day. Lampasas County is up to 347 cases with 33 active as of yesterday. That is 8 more than the day before. The State of Texas reported 3,234 new cases and 3,190 Texans are hospitalized for the Coronavirus



Important Election Dates

For those that need to register to vote, Monday is the last day to



do so. There are 11 days until early voting starts on October 13th, 21 days left to request a mail-in ballot by October 23rd, and 32 days left until the election.

Early voting is expanded this year and has 14 days from and ends October 30th. Mail in ballots must be requested by October 23rd, but the postal service recommends requesting this by October 19th. In Lampasas, early voting will take place in the County Annex Conference Room at 409 S. Pecan.

Polling places will generally have guidelines for social distancing and other precautions in place. Poll workers will probably have masks, but masks are recommended for voters, but not required. The polling places are generally asking for voters to maintain 6 feet of separation from others, self screen, bring your own pen or pencil with eraser or stylus, hand sanitizer, and use curbside voting if warranted. Lampasas will offer curbside voting; you can call 512-556-8271 ext. 206 to find out if you are eligible. If you wish to drop off your ballot in person, you must go in person to the elections office in Lampasas County to do so. And remember, polling locations on Election Day are different from Early Voting locations.



Statewide Student Enrollment Declining



State Education Officials announced Thursday that they will give schools an additional 6 weeks before cutting funding for districts seeing declines in students due to Covid-19. Texas was already agreeing to fund

schools for the first 12 weeks based on projected numbers. For most schools, it will now cover the entire first semester. The state's funding of schools is based on attendance, in classrooms, or remotely.

To receive the extension, school districts must offer in-person instruction to all whose parents choose that option. They must also continue to try and find students that are missing from enrollment data.

Many students in Texas have fallen off the grid, and become unreachable. School staff are calling cell phones, and going to student homes looking for missing students. Dr. Chane Rascoe, Lampasas ISD Superintendent shared that Lampasas ISD saw very little decline and currently has 3,390 students enrolled. According to a TEA calculation, 1 million of the state's 5.5 million students are attending in-person classes. Many are staying home struggling with internet and device issues.

Many teachers groups are criticizing State Education Officials for tying funding to being open for in-person learning, saying the local health authorities should make those decisions.
