## The Weather

**The high yesterday 85° This morning's low 55°**  
**Hurricane Delta** probably won't bring any rain to Central Texas, but the forecasters say we will have some thin clouds from the storm. The forecast high temperatures for tomorrow for our area are presenting a challenge to the forecasters, as the cloud cover from Delta could change everything. Right now it looks like mid 80's to the east and climbing temperatures as you move west. This weekend is looking to be very hot, especially Sunday when our forecast high is to be 99°. A cool front is expected Monday and Monday night to bring things back to seasonal highs.  
**Today:** Sunny with a high temperature near 87°. Winds will become light from the E in the afternoon.  
**Tonight:** Partly cloudy, with a low around 66° and winds becoming calm.  
**Friday:** Mostly sunny a high near 84°. The wind will be from the NE at 5-10 mph.  
**Overnight Friday:** Mostly clear with a low near 62°. The wind will become calm.  
**Saturday:** Sunny with high temperatures near 93°. Winds will be light from the W-SW then become calm.  
**Saturday night:** Look for clear skies and a low near 65°, with S-SE winds at 5-10 mph.  
**Sunday:** Hot with a high near 99° and SW wind at 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

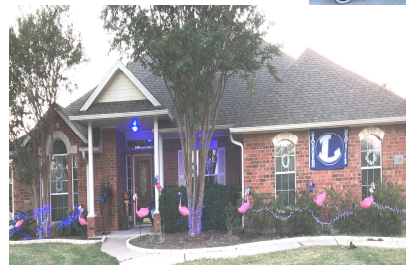

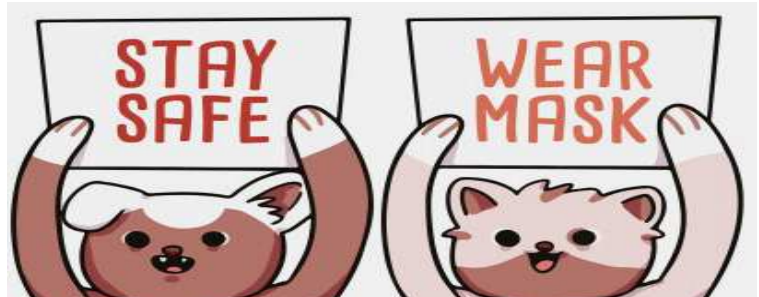


