Columbus Day

Columbus Day will be observed next Monday, October 11th. The County Offices will all be closed, as well as the banks and the postal service. The City of Lampasas, however will be open.

Fall Brush Chipping

The City of Lampasas will begin its fall brush chipping in the city. November 1st-5th, will be the NW section of the city, west of Key St. and north of 1st St. November 8-12, will be the SW section, west of Key Ave and south of 1st St. November 15-19, will be the SE section of the city, east of Key Ave and south of 1st St. November 22-24, will be the NE section of the city, east of Key Ave. and north of 1st St. November 25 & 26 the city will be closed for holidays. November 29- December 3, they will continue the NE section of the city and finish up all sections of city brush chipping.

Lampasas City Council

The Lampasas City Council will hold regular meetings on Monday, October 11th beginning with the workshop session at 5:30pm. The agenda for the workshop session includes a presentation from the Water Control Improvement District, updates on the Covid-19 pandemic, discussion regarding Hostess House design and construction specifications, discussion regarding the design and contract from SPA skateparks, and discussion regarding the base pricing and design for the Campbell Park Pavilion.

The regular session will begin at 6pm and the agenda includes the consent agenda, discussion and possible action regarding the August 2021 investment report, routine matters to include the city manager's operational report. In new business there will be discussion and possible action regarding the award of design and specification contract for renovations to the Hostess House in an amount not to exceed \$130,570. There will also be discussion and possible action regarding the award to design/build contract with SPA Skate parks for design and construction of a skatepark in Campbell Park. Also discussed will be the base pricing and design with options for Campbell Park pavilion in an amount not to exceed \$175,885, discussion regarding RFP for Airport Terminal Improvements, and also discussion for the award of contract for utility line tree trimming to LCRA and McCoy tree surgery in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.

Council will also discuss appointments and re-appointments to various boards and commissions.

Coronavirus Numbers

Statewide, on October 7th, there were 5,935 new and 2,160 probable cases, along with 7,117 in the hospital. There were 257 deaths from Covid reported as well. Locally, in the last 14 days, Lampasas has seen 81 confirmed cases according to the DSHS website, with 7 being confirmed yesterday. The state estimate is 153 active cases in Lampasas County.

Hazardous Waste Disposal

The City of Temple Solid Waste Division is hosting our annual Household Hazardous Waste event this October! The event will be Saturday October 23 from 9am to 2pm at 3210 E. Ave H in Temple.

This is open to residents of all 7 counties served by CTCOG including Lampasas county. This is a contactless, drive-thru event where residents can properly and safely dispose of household waste not commonly accepted in curbside garbage and recycling.
