Badgers Begin District Play

The Badgers played a solid game against the Burnet Bulldogs in Burnet last night, winning 24-7. Offensively, the Badgers were 12 of 22 in passing with 139 yards and 1 interception. On the ground, the Badgers had 45 carries for 181 yards. Jett Walker led the pack with 15 carries, 83 yards and a touchdown, followed by Aden Rascoe with 11 carries and 72 yards. Rascoe also had a 19yd rushing touchdown as well as David Flores and Jett Walker for a 6yd touchdown and an 8yd touchdown, respectively. In receiving, Owen Stubbs had 4 receptions for 70 yards and Ethan Moreno had 5 receptions for 39 yards. Landon Richardson scored a 10yd field goal and kicked 3 extra points. The Badgers played a strong defensive game, forcing a punt nearly every time the bulldogs had the ball. Aiden Shaw blocked 2 passes from the bulldogs, and Brock Langford had an interception in the fourth quarter.

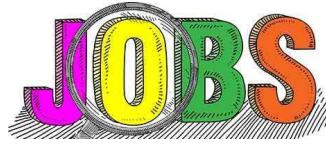

The Columbus Day Holiday will be observed on Monday, October 10th this year. The banks will be closed, as well as the county offices and the local schools. The City of Lampasas offices will be open for business as usual, as will the Radiogram offices.

Uvalde ISD Suspends Police Department

Uvalde school officials on Friday suspended all of the district police department's activities following the firing of a recently hired district officer who was revealed to have been among the first state troopers to respond to the deadly school shooting in May.

Lt. Miguel Hernandez and Ken Mueller were placed on leave, and other officers employed with the department will fill other roles in the district, according to a Uvalde Consolidated Independent School District press release issued Friday. Mueller decided to retire, the release said. The release did not specify why Hernandez and Mueller were placed on leave. A district spokesperson did not immediately return phone and email messages.

Hours after the announcement, Uvalde school district Superintendent Hal Harrell told staff in a memo that he planned to retire. In his three decades at the district, which he also graduated from, Harrell was a teacher, principal, assistant superintendent and deputy superintendent before he was hired for his current position in November 2018.

The district's decision to suspend its police department arrived 10 days after protesters set up at the Uvalde CISD administrative building to demand the removal of officers from campus grounds until investigations into the police department's response to the shooting are complete.

The district said decisions regarding the future of the department had been pending the results of two investigations, but it suspended the department's activities Friday, citing "recent developments that have uncovered additional concerns with

department operations."

Upon suspending the police department, the district asked DPS for extra troopers for campus and extracurricular activities, according to the Friday news release.

Ft. Hood to Change Names

The U.S. Department of Defense is set to change the name of Texas' Fort Hood, America's largest active-duty armored military post, to pay homage to a four-star Hispanic general instead of its original namesake, a Confederate general.

Defense Secretary Lloyd J. Austin announced the pending change Thursday in a memo to top Pentagon officials and agreed to a recommendation that the base be called Fort Cavazos. That name was previously recommended by the Naming Commission, which Congress created to suggest new names or removal of names and symbols that commemorate Confederate figures.

Federal officials have until Jan. 1, 2024, to finalize the transition. The change is part of a broader movement from the naming commission to have the DOD rename 1,111 installations and facilities. Eight other military bases that derive their names from Confederate figures are also slated to have their names changed.
