While the humidity is high in our area, the precipitation is expected to remain to our east. The high temperatures today will depend on how long the clouds take to clear the area. This weekend will begin another extended rain-free forecast, and expect well above normal temperatures this weekend. October weather can be pleasant, but the forecasters are calling for a sweaty weekend due to the tropical moisture brought in by hurricane Delta. Sunday looks to be the hottest day of the weekend and we may see the triple digits. Temperatures Monday will still reach the upper 80's before the weak cool front moves through.

Saturday: Sunny with a high temperature near 91° and a light W-NW wind.

Saturday night: Look for mostly clear skies with a low near 64°. Light E-SE wind will become calm.


Sunday: Sunny and hot with a high near 98°. Winds will be S-SW at 5-10 mph. .





Local Area Sales Tax Report

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced

Wednesday that there were 765.3 million in local sales tax allocations for October 2020, 2.8% less than in October 2019. These allocations are based on August sales from businesses that report tax monthly.

In nearby Hamilton County, Evant received a check for \$4523.55, 15.24% over the same time period last year. The city of Hamilton, saw a 1.82% increase to \$49,993.81 this year. In San Saba County, San Saba received a rebate for \$38,517.84, up 11.32 % from last year.

In Lampasas County, the City of Lometa saw an increase during this time frame of 10.21% which garnered them a rebate check for \$6,956.27. Kempner saw a decrease of 18.10% for a rebate of \$8,194.79, and the City of Lampasas saw an increase of 13.79% for a rebate of \$185,110.58.
