## City Council

**The Lampasas City Council** will meet on Monday, October 10<sup>th</sup> for regularly scheduled meetings.

The workshop session will begin at 5:30pm and the agenda includes discussion regarding the Comprehensive Plan.

The regular session of the City Council will get underway at 6pm. The agenda includes a public hearing to receive citizen comments regarding a request to rezone property from Commercial to Single Family Residential on E. Ave J between Casbeer and White St.

Also included on the agenda is the consent agenda to include discussion and possible action regarding the August 2022 investment report. The City Managers report to include information on the Skate Park, the Calvert Building Pecan Tree, the community lunch and EMS dispatching as well as the Lampasas County Chamber and Visitor Agreement. In New business there will be discussion and possible action regarding the selection of the firm

for Wayfinding Sign Master Plan, discussion and possible action regarding selection of contractor to remove concrete slab, footings, wash basins and piers at the City of Lampasas Industrial Park. Discussion and possible action regarding the annual contract with McCoy Tree Service through contract services with LCRA for tree trimming services in the amount of \$149,963.23, discussion and possible action regarding the first reading of an ordinance to amend the City of Lampasas Code of Ordinances to include the Campbell Park Pavilion, and discussion and possible action regarding approval of installation and removal of Christmas lights at WM Brook park to H & H Tree Service in the amount of \$30,000 to be disbursed in three installments.

## Registering to Vote

(Texas Tribune) Tuesday, Oct. 11, is the deadline in Texas to register to vote to be able to participate in the 2022 midterm elections, where voters will cast their ballots on everything from the gubernatorial race between Gov. Greg Abbott and Beto O'Rourke to local races for county judge and state representative.

Texas is one of a handful of states with a voter registration deadline 30 days before the election. Here's what you need to know about checking your status and registering to vote before the end of day Tuesday. *(cont'd on back)*

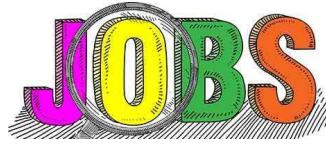

(cont'd from front) You can check to see if you're registered and verify your information on the Texas secretary of state's website. You'll need one of the following three combinations to log in:

- 1) Your Texas driver's license number and date of birth.
- 2) Your first and last names, date of birth and county you reside in.
- 3) Your date of birth and Voter Unique Identifier number, which appears on your voter registration certificate.

Who can register to vote in Texas? U.S. citizens in Texas can register to vote in the election if they are 18 or older or if they will be 18 by Election Day, which is Nov. 8. Additionally, you can register to vote through the Texas Department of Public Safety while renewing your driver's license, even if you're doing so online. This is the only form of online registration in the state.

After you register to vote, you will receive a voter registration certificate within 30 days. It'll contain your voter information, including the Voter Unique Identifier number needed to update your voter registration online. If the certificate has incorrect information, you'll need to note corrections and send it to your local voter registrar as soon as possible.

Tuesday is also the last day to submit an address change for the midterm elections. You can report an address or name change online. You should do this if you've moved since the last time you voted, especially if you have moved to a different county or political subdivision or have legally taken a different name.

If a county suspects you have changed address but your registration has not been updated, you may be placed on a "suspense list." Voters placed on the suspense list can still vote if they update or confirm their address before the voter registration deadline for an election or fill out a "statement of residence" when voting, but they may have to vote at their previous polling location or vote on a limited ballot.
