## The Weather

The High yesterday 83° The Low this morning 57°

The forecasters say we are looking at a warm and windy with low humidity and elevated fire danger in areas to the west. A cold front is expected to move through the area tomorrow, bringing a noticeable wind shift, but not until temperatures top out in the 80's.

**Today:** Sunny with a high near 91° this afternoon. The wind will be S-SW at 5-10 mph increasing to 10-15 mph in the afternoon.

**Tonight:** Mostly clear skies and the low will get down to 67° by morning. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph gusting to 20 mph.

**Thursday:** Mostly sunny with the temperature topping out at near 82°. Winds will be S at 5-15 mph shifting N in the afternoon. Winds could gust to 20 mph.

**Thursday Night:** Clouds will be on the increase with the temperature dropping to 53° or so. The wind will be N-NE near 15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

**Friday:** Mostly sunny and a high near 69°. Winds will be NE at 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

**Friday Night:** Mostly clear skies and a low near 49°. Winds will become light from the E-NE becoming calm



## City Manager Notes

Lampasas City Manger Finley de Graffenried was in Lampasas Radio studios this morning for his weekly visit with Ronnie Witcher.

The first thing discussed was the increase in Covid-19 cases in Lampasas County. Mr. de Graffenreid explained that a number of these cases were in multi-generational homes. At last count, we had 39 cases and 1 in the hospital. They spoke about the re-opening of bars, and the City Manager believes that this will impact about half a dozen businesses in the Lampasas area.

Mr. Witcher questioned the City Manager about the vacating of an alleyway and the combining of 7 lots in the area of 1003 S. Key Ave., which was the Aaron's building, plus the vacated alleyway. Obviously someone is putting a piece of land together, and Mr. de Graffenreid hinted that it is a restaurant. If there are city utilities in the aforementioned alleyway, they will have to be checked and possibly dug up.

Drive-in movies are possibly going to be offered to residents, since the Movie-in-the-Park are no longer offered.

Mr. de Graffenreid also spoke about the issue of pedestrian crossing on 281 S. in the Putters-n-Gutters area. The issue of parking on 281 was addressed in a previous meeting. There are no plans for more lights, or walkways being built. The City Managers said residents will have to go to Naruna Rd. to cross 281S.

The pavilion at Campbell Park will be about 5000-6000 sq. ft., similar to the pavilion at Hancock Park.

Also, new internet companies are coming to town. This may create an issue of having too many lines on a utility pole. If this happens, according to the city, the company will have to absorb the cost of a new utility pole.

## Commissioners' Court



Lampasas County Commissioners held their regular meeting yesterday due to Monday being a county holiday.

The Agenda included the consent agenda which was approved as presented. During public comments, a resident that built a house on CR 3940 spoke

about trying to work with Commissioner Rainwater on placing a culvert. If placing the culvert is not possible, please let her know, or let her know when the work can be completed by the county.

The final plat for Rylan Ranch was approved with the contingency of the construction bond. The River Hills Ranches, phase 2B, had no action taken. The issue is that at this time, the developer does not have the standard 60 foot right of way, which is standard for construction. The developer only has a 50 ft. right-of-way at this time. 60 feet is the standard to allow law enforcement, EMS, and fire trucks to access the subdivision. The River Hills Ranches phase III preliminary plat was approved. The Lampasas county museum is requesting financial assistance in the amount of 5,000. It seems Covid has struck another local business. Judge Hoyer tabled the matter in order to give the county the opportunity to see if funds are available. We will hear more on this at the next commissioner's court.

Approved was the 2021 county holidays which is a total of 14 days. Also the commissioner's court dates for 2021 were approved. The meetings will still be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Monday every month excluding Columbus day which will be held the following day.
