The Weather

The high yesterday 90° This morning's low 69°

A strong cold front is expected in Central Texas later this morning, bringing a noticeable wind change and possibly some cloud cover. The forecaster expect it to be in our area around 11am, and sustained winds are expected to be near 20 mph, gusting to 30 mph. Gusty winds are expected to stay with us into the evening, but may decrease later in the night. Tomorrow expect a light breeze from the north, and highs in the upper 60's to low 70's.

Today: Mostly sunny with a high temperature near 77°. Winds will be from the W at 5-10 mph, then shift N at 10-15 gusting to 25 this afternoon.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy, with a low around 53°. Winds will be NE at 10-20 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Friday: Mostly sunny a high near 72°. The wind will be from the E-NE at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Overnight Friday: Mostly clear with a low near 52°. The wind will become calm.

Saturday: Mostly sunny with high temperatures near 80°. Winds will be S-SE at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Saturday night: Look for mostly clear skies and a low near 65°, with S winds at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.



Lampasas ISD Chosen for Quick Covid Pilot Test



Dr. Chane Rascoe shared the following with Lampasas Radio this morning: "We are planning to partner with our local clinic to allow rapid testing given at the clinic to all symptomatic students and/or staff. Biggest benefit to the district, clinic, and community will be making rapid testing available for free locally. Currently, parents and staff must go out of town to have a rapid test. Testing locally will also increase efficiency of notification to Dr. Hay to start contact tracing sooner. Currently, there are significant delays in this process.

As a part of the pilot, asymptomatic testing of staff will be offered, but it is volunteer only. We plan to have the first one Monday at the high school."

From Governor Abbott:

Governor Greg Abbott, the Texas Education Agency (TEA), and the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) today announced the creation of a COVID-19 Rapid Testing Pilot Program for Texas school systems. This program will help schools conduct rapid tests of district employees and students — with the written permission of their parents — to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 on campuses. Through this pilot program, TDEM will provide participating school systems with COVID-19 rapid antigen tests that will be administered to students, teachers, and staff who choose to participate. Schools enrolled in the program will also receive personal protective equipment (PPE) to safely administer the rapid tests, which produce reliable results within 15 minutes.

"Thank you to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for providing these advanced antigen tests to the State of Texas. This rapid testing pilot program will be an effective strategy to protect the health and safety of students and staff while helping to further ensure that Texas students have access to a quality education throughout the pandemic and beyond."

Lampasas Radio hears from Dr. Georgia Hay that Lampasas county now has 385 total cases with 34 active with one older patient in their 80's in the hospital. The State of Texas reported 4,564 new cases yesterday, with 4,131 Texans hospitalized for coronavirus
