The Weather



The High yesterday 82° The Low this morning 71°

Another round of energy should come through Central Texas by this afternoon and bring scattered light rain showers. Change is on the way, though with a cold front moving in to NW Texas, and expected to move across the Metroplex around sunset, and reach the Texas coast by sunrise tomorrow.

Today: Mostly cloudy with a high temperature near 87° and S-SW wind at 5-10 mph, becoming W in the afternoon. There is a 50% chance of showers and storms, mainly after 1pm.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with a low near 56°, and S-SW wind near 5-10 mph becoming N 10-15 mph and gusting to 20 mph. The chance of showers and storms is 50% with most of the precipitation between 10pm and 1am.

Wednesday: Mostly sunny with a high near 70°, and winds from the N-NE at 10-15 mph, gusting to 20 mph.

Wednesday Night: Partly cloudy with a low near 50°, and N-NE wind near 5-10 mph becoming light in the evening.

The rest of the week: Warm and mostly sunny on Thursday, and sunny on Friday with temperatures climbing into the 80's and 90's before the next cold front on Sunday night or Monday.

City Council Notes

The Lampasas City Council met yesterday in Council Chambers.

The following items were discussed;

- Campbell Park will be getting bathrooms, and placement should be worked out by mid-December.
- Drainage issues near the Presbyterian church on Chestnut St., where the water collects and damages the sidewalks, and makes them dangerous for people in wheelchairs or walkers.
- The Lampasas Courtyard Square Association is requesting funds for marketing and upgrading the Billboard Advertisement Signs.
- Modification of a part-time building maintenance position to a full time position was approved. 3
- The first reading of an ordinance amending the City of Lampasas Noise Ordinance was approved.
- Melissa Unger of the Lampasas Chamber of Commerce asked for funds to revise the Chamber's website for 2020 A request was submitted by the Lampasas County Chamber of Commerce for hotel occupancy tax funds was approved in the amount of \$1718.50 to offset expenses for the Hunter's Welcome event.

District Court Notes

Lampasas Courthouse was the site of 27th District Court Docket Call on October 11th. Presiding over the Court was 27th district Judge John Gauntt.

Altogether 42 cases were brought to the court, 34 of them involved men and 8 of them involved women. Anthony Thornton, of Austin failed to appear on a possession PG1 4-200 grams charge, David Barzi was FTA on a charge of evading arrest with a vehicle, Meghan Bray failed to appear on the charge of unauthorized absence from a community correction facility, and Mindi Harris of Midland was found to have insufficient bond on a possession charge, PG1 4-200 grams.

There were 21 cases involving possession of a controlled substance, (all PG1). There were 8 cases each of possession less than 1 gram, and possession of 4-200 grams. There were 2 cases of possession of PG1 1-4 grams, and 2 cases of possession of less than a gram in a drug free zone, and on e case of manufacture & delivery of 4-200 grams. There was 1 DWI case of felony repetition. There was one case of burglary of a building and 3 cases of theft of firearm, and on e for evading arrest with a vehicle. There was 1 fraud case. Crimes causing personal harm included 4 cases for assault of a family member, 2 cases for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. There were 2 cases for unlawful possession of a firearm by a felon, and one case of unauthorized absence. There was one case for online solicitation of a minor/sexual conduct, where Christopher Comacho saw his case reset until 11/15. There was one sexual assault case and two cases involving sexual assault of a minor. (Cont'd on back)



The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept Blotter for Monday shows early morning arrests as John Champion, 44, of Copperas Cove and Billy Shoaf, 38, of Gatesville were arrested in the 1700 block of CTE for possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram and possession of drug paraphernalia at 3:28am. Janet Walsh, 61, of Lometa was arrested in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss Dr. at 7:54 am for possession of a controlled substance PG3 less than 28 grams, possession of a dangerous drug, and DWI 2nd.

A suspicious person was reported in the 100 block of N. Key at 8:22am, then a criminal trespass was reported in the 700 block of E. Hackberry at 9am. A suspicious act was reported on Acorn St. at 9:44am. There was a domestic disturbance in the 800 block of N. Key at 11:55am, then the afternoon shows a burglary of a motor vehicle reported in the 900 block of N. Key at 2:37pm.

There was a theft in the 400 block of S. Pecan at 3:49pm, a suspicious act in the 1600 block of 281 S. at 4:01pm, and a disturbance in the 700 block of Dent St. at 5:28pm.

A 33 year old Lampasas man was arrested in the 2700 block of 281S at 6:48pm on a TDCJ warrant.

The Sheriff's Dept. blotter for Monday shows Lometa with livestock issues and a reported theft. Kempner shows livestock issues, an attended death, and a medical call. Out in the county there were livestock issues, animal problems, reported disturbances, civil matters, a burglary and a shots fired call. Deputies went into Cove for an animal problem and a civil matter.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of a 31 year old Austin man for possession of marijuana less than 2 oz., and a 42 year old Lillian Alabama man for disregarding an official traffic control device, violation of promise to appear, and resisting arrest.

Of the 42 cases, 7 were decided, with Justin Dunlap of Lometa, receiving 6 years adjudicated probation on an assault of a family member charge, Christina Jiminez of Midland was sentenced to 6 months of state jail plus costs with credit for 100 days for possession of PG1 less than a gram. Jeffrey Gilley of Mabank, Texas was punished with 4 years TDCJ for sexual assault of a child, and Allen Wells, of Brownwood was sentenced to 5 years adjudicated probation plus a \$2000 fine for sexual assault. Saul Rodriguez of Killeen was sentenced to 6 years adjudicated probation, and must complete ISF on the charges of possession of PG1 4-200 grams, and aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. Henry Sanchez of Lampasas saw his possession of less than a gram charge reduced to a misdemeanor, and was sentenced to 153 days in the Lampasas County Jail, with the same number of days credited, plus costs and fees. The balance of the cases were reset.
