The Badgers played a solid game against the Taylor Ducks on Badger Field, winning 42-13. Offensively, the Badgers had 419yds to the Duck's 282yds. The Badger offense was 15 of 22 in passing for 204 yards, and had 32 carries for 215 yards. David Flores had a 36yd rushing touchdown in the first half. Flores also connected with Carter Johnson for an 18yd touchdown pass and with Aden Rascoe for a 6vd touchdown pass. Ethan Moreno also had 2 touchdowns from Flores off 33yds and 9yds, respectively. Jett Walker had 9 carries for 85yds and a 4yd touchdown run in the first quarter. Aden Rascoe had 13 carries for 76yds. Landon Richardson kicked 6 extra points. The Badgers played a strong defensive game, causing quick turnovers and coming away with 2 interceptions. Carson Fields recovered a fumble in the third quarter. Reed Jerome had two interceptions, once in the first quarter and again in the second quarter. Levi Rivera and Carson Fields had several tackles, resulting in short drives for the Ducks.



Cell Phone Mishaps

According to a story by secure data recovery, while the personal technology that we have daily access to is incredibly capable and complex, with great power, comes great responsibility — and often, many mishaps. From cracked screens to water damage, many of us have a horror story when it comes to being human and handling technology.

The good news is, sometimes our devices and their data are recoverable. We allow you to protect, back up, and retrieve data

from damaged devices that are central to our lives. But which devices are the most damaged and who are the biggest offenders? A survey was conducted across the United States of over 2,200 respondents to find out which parts of the United States are the most reckless with their devices.

Key findings: Texas, Missouri, and Oklahoma are the states most likely to have had to replace a phone due to breaking it. When it comes to dropped phones, 44% of Americans do it at least once a week. Bathrooms are a particular issue for 23% of Americans who have dropped their phone in the toilet. Concerning data loss, 31% of Americans have broken a phone and completely lost the data it contained.

States that break, crack, and drop their phones the most: Even though our phones are our main window of communication, they are all too easy to break. In fact, over 3 in 4 Americans (76%) have had to replace a phone due to breaking it. However, the cost is not just the price of a new phone: 31% have broken a phone and completely lost the data it contained.

We sought to determine how many people in each state have had to replace a phone due to breaking it. The states at the top of the list include Texas (95%), Missouri (88%), and Oklahoma (88%).

95% of Texas residents have had to replace at least 1 phone due to breaking it (ranks 1st nationally).

29% of Texas residents currently have a cracked phone (tied for 1st nationally).

45% of Texas residents drop their phones at least weekly (the national average is 44%).

The most common phone mishaps: 1. Cracking the screen 2. Throwing it by accident 3. Spilling a drink on it
