The Weather



The high yesterday 83° This morning's low 65°

Today: The morning clouds should drift away eventually and turn our day into a sunny one. The high should reach about 84° and the south wind of about 10 mph could gust up to 20 mph on occasion.

Tonight: Partly cloudy, with a low around 65° and the S-SE wind light at around 5 mph.

Wednesday: Mostly cloudy skies again in the morning but burning off for afternoon with a high near 83°. The light 5 mph S-SE wind will continue for the day and evening.

Overnight, the temperature should drop to about 64°.

The Rest of the Week: Thursday will bring sunshine and about an 84° high with a little more south wind than in the previous few days. Friday will bring continued sunshine and only a mid-70s high. The wind will shift to northerly in the afternoon, then go to morning on Saturday which should have a mid-70s high.

Sunday will be sunny and back to low 80s.

The Covid 19 Report:



The Governor's conditional order to reopen bars in Texas has seen Lampasas and other Counties doing just that. That will allow many of the state's businesses that offer alcoholic beverages on-premise but don't serve food to begin their recovery attempts.

The above, in spite of the recent upsurge in Covid cases in the state. The report from Monday afternoon shows that the state has seen 828,527 cases since they began keeping records. As of Monday there were 82,930 active cases, up by 5.3% from last Friday's 17,022 active cases. Some 16,812 people had died from Covid in that report and the death number continues to increase.

In Lampasas it appears that the active case number as of Monday was just 17, way down from last Friday's 31. So far Lampasas has seen 397 cases of Covid with 11 deaths.
