## Annual Brush Chipping Program

The City of Lampasas will begin the annual brush chipping program in November. Brush can be no longer than 4 feet in length, no lumber or trash will be picked up, and the bundle must be out by the curb, no alley pick up. There will be no charge for brush drop off at the collection station for the month of November.

The program will begin on October 31<sup>st</sup> –November 4<sup>th</sup> in the NW section of the city. W of Key Ave. and N of 1<sup>st</sup> St. November 7<sup>th</sup>-November 10<sup>th</sup> will be brush pick up for the SW section of the city. W. of Key Ave. and S of 1<sup>st</sup> St. November 14<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> will see crews in the SE section of the city. E. of Key Ave. and S. of 1<sup>st</sup> St. November 21<sup>st</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> will see pick up in the NE section of the city. E. of Key Ave. and N of 1<sup>st</sup> St. After the Thanksgiving holiday crews will continue in the NE section of the city and finish up all sections.

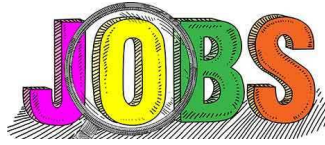

## The Blotter

There was a reported theft in the 600 block of S. Western St. at 9:51pm and a criminal trespass was reported in the 200 block of E. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. at 10:10pm.

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Blotter shows Lometa with livestock issues and a medical call. In Kempner there were livestock issues, a reported assault, and alarm calls. Out in the county there were animal issues, medical calls, a civil matter and a reported trespassing. Deputies went into Cove on a reported burglary, a mental health call, a fish & game call and a structure fire.

## Thanksgiving Closings

According to a story by CBS news, as Thanksgiving — and the biggest shopping day of the year, Black Friday — approach, major stores are announcing their holiday hours. There are two common approaches: stay closed for the holiday, or open early for Black Friday crowds.

Kohl's announced on Tuesday that all of its stores will once again be closed on Thanksgiving Day this year, after seeing success when it closed stores for the holiday in 2020 and 2021.

While in the past, many retail chains started their Black Friday sales a day early, closing on Thanksgiving became popular in 2020. That's in part because it gave retail workers, who were considered essential workers, a break during the pandemic, and also limited crowds.

Last year, Kohl's said it saw a positive response to its Thanksgiving closure in 2020, "as well as evolving preferences in how and when customers want to shop during the holiday season." Customers can still shop online any time.

Target followed the trend of staying closed on Thanksgiving 2020, and in 2021 it announced that the move would become permanent. "What started as a temporary measure driven by the pandemic is now our new standard — one that recognizes our ability to deliver on our guests' holiday wishes both within and well beyond store hours," Target CEO Brian Cornell wrote in a 2021 note to employees obtained by The Associated Press.

Even Walmart and Best Buy, both known for their Black Friday deals, decided to close on Thanksgiving in recent years. Walmart hasn't announced its plans for this year, but Best Buy said it will remain closed.

While many stores are expected to continue the trend of staying closed on Thanksgiving, some may stay open. Dollar General, for example, has stayed open on Thanksgiving in recent years. Michaels craft stores will stay open, as will Big Lots, Bass Pro Shop, Kmart, RadioShack and others, according to TheBlackFriday.com. Grocery stores often stay open, with limited hours, for last-minute Thanksgiving dinner needs.

Locally our HEB plans on being open from 6am-2pm, and WalMart and the Dollar Tree will be closed.

## School Safety Audits

A story by CBS Austin tells us that The Texas School Safety Center may be visiting your student's school unannounced. It's all part of the center's school intruder detection audits.

Governor Greg Abbott requested a school review of Texas Public Schools back in June after the tragic mass school shooting in Uvalde.

CBS Austin reached out to several area districts to ask if any of their schools have been audited. Austin ISD says at least 12 schools have been audited and one audit turned up an issue that was soon corrected. The district would not detail the issue.

Pflugerville ISD has only had one campus receive an audit and it passed. Hays CISD has had four total and passed them all. Eanes ISD has had two campuses inspected "with no findings." Hutto ISD has only had one safety audit and passed. Georgetown ISD had two safety audits and passed. Lake Travis ISD said two out of 11 schools have been audited and both passed with no findings. The district said after all of the schools are audited, staff will assess the results and "determine next steps."

If safety deficiencies are found in schools, they have a set amount of time to make changes.
