The Weather



The high yesterday 86° This morning's low 68°

The big weather story is the cold front moving through Central Texas tomorrow. Forecasters say it should be through the region by midday. Our high temperature is forecast at 10am, then falling to near 50° in the afternoon, with gusty winds. The cold and clouds are expected to clear out by Saturday and Sunday is forecast to be in the mid 80's. Sunday may see some wind picking up in front of another cold front on Monday.

Today: Mostly cloudy with gradual clearing and a high near 85°. Winds will be from the S at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Increasing clouds with a low around 70°. Winds will be continue in the night from the S at 5-10 mph.

Friday: Mostly cloudy with a high near 74° forecasted at 10am. The temperature will then fall to near 50° in the afternoon. The wind will be from the NW at 5-10, then becoming blustery in the afternoon at 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Overnight Friday: Mostly cloudy with a low near 50°. The wind will be N at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph, then decreasing overnight.

Saturday: Partly sunny with high temperatures near 72°. Winds will become light from the S-SE in the afternoon.

Saturday night: Look for mostly clear skies and a low near 61°, with light S-SE winds.

Despite everything, Lampasas High School got their Homecoming Parade and pep rally yesterday evening, and a good time was had by the students and teachers.



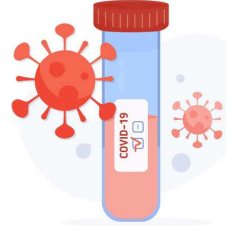
There was a small-town parade with student athletes, followed by a pep-rally at Badger Stadium. The Lampasas High School Band marched in the parade and performed at the pep rally.

Lampasas ISD

Dr. Chane Rascoe, Superintendent of Lampasas ISD posted on the LISD website the information about the rapid-testing program. Governor Abbott chose Lampasas ISD as one of the 8 school districts conducting the pilot program. The TEA, and Texas Division of Emergency Management are working directly with districts to accomplish this program. Employees and students of LISD will be able to be tested free of charge with the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Rapid Ag test. Testing started this week with 42 tests of asymptomatic staff members due to the student holiday. There was one positive result.



Dr. Rascoe shares that Symptomatic rapid testing for LISD staff and students has started at the FMC clinic. Students and/or staff can go to the clinic and receive a free COVID test at this time. Staff needs to call to make an appointment, and for students, call FMC and specify it is an LISD student and which campus. They will then confirm enrollment. If your child is sent home with symptoms, they will be given a form by the school nurse to take to the FMC clinic. Results are available in 15 minutes.


Coronavirus Update



The last report from Dr. Hay that was received at Lampasas Radio was on Monday with only 17 active cases. There have been 397 cases and 11 deaths in Lampasas County. The State of Texas saw 4,991 new cases yesterday and 4,782 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.

The Lampasas ISD website has updated data for Covid-19 on a campus-by-campus basis. It shows as of yesterday; Hanna Springs Elementary with 0 active/2 recovered students and 0 active/3 recovered staff; Kline Whitis Elementary has 0 active/1 recovered student and 0 active/recovered staff; Taylor Creek Elementary has 0 active/recovered students and 0 active/1 recovered staff; Lampasas Middle School has 0 active/2 recovered students and 0 active/1 recovered staff; Lampasas High School has 3 Active/17 recovered students and 1 active /0 recovered staff.
