The Weather

Yesterday's high 88° This morning's low 62°

Today: The high temperature will be near 88° with sunny skies. Winds will be S-SW at 10-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Tonight: Look for partly cloudy skies with a low near 65°. Wind from the S will be near 15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Sunday: Mostly sunny and the high temperature will climb to near 87°. Wind will be S near 15-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.

Sunday Night: Mostly cloudy skies with a low temperature near 69° and a 20% chance of showers. The SE wind will be near 15 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.

Badgers fall to the Wolves

The Badgers played a tough game against the Davenport Wolves in Davenport (San Antonio), losing 55-34. Offensively, the Badgers had 487yds to the Wolves' 486yds. Jett Walker had a touchdown from David Flores of 4yds. Flores also connected with Owen Stubbs for a 65yd touchdown pass and with Ethan Moreno for a 9yd touchdown pass. Aden Rascoe had a touchdown from Carter Johnson of 70yds, and Johnson had a touchdown from Flores of 27yds. Landon Richardson kicked 3 extra points. Defensively, the Badgers were able to keep the score close in the first half. Ryker Morua and Levi Rivera had several tackles, resulting in short drives for the Wolves in the fourth quarter.

Lampasas City Council to Meet

The Lampasas City Council will meet Monday, October 24th for regularly scheduled meetings.

The regular meeting will begin at 6pm and the agenda includes discussion and possible action regarding the second reading of an ordinance to rezone property from commercial to single family residential on FM 580 between Casbeer St. and White St., the second reading of an ordinance to amend the Lampasas City code of Ordinances to include a fee schedule for Campbell Park Pavilion. There will be board and departmental reports, the City Manager's Operational Report and Mayor's comments. In new business Council will have discussion and possible action on the following: approval of Master Cooperative Purchasing Agreement between the Sheriffs Association of Texas and the City of Lampasas, the purchase of a 2023 Chevy Tahoe for the Lampasas Fire Dept. in an amount not to exceed \$65,000, purchase of SRO equipment as defined in the Interlocal Agreement with LISD in August 2022 in an amount up to \$49,500, purchase of the EMD Radio Upgrade as defined in the Interlocal Agreement with Lampasas County in the amount of \$84,411.10.
