## The Weather



The High Yesterday (morning):  $73^\circ$  The Low this Morning:  $47^\circ$ 

The forecasters say to expect temperatures in the 60's today, and a few degrees warmer tonight. Tomorrow should be in the 80's. Texas will see changes beginning Sunday night into Monday. This strong cold front is expected in the Central Texas area Monday Morning. The forecast high temperature on Monday is 57° at 10am falling through the day to near 40° Monday evening. Wind chills are expected to be in the 30's. Precipitation chances will move in with the front, and continue through Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday morning. By the end of the week, we should have more seasonable temperatures.

**Today:** Mostly cloudy this morning with clearing this afternoon, and a high near 66°. Light N-NW wind at 5-10 mph.

**Tonight:** Mostly clear, with a low around 53°. Light S-SE wind. **Sunday:** Sunny, with a high near 84°. South wind at 5 to 15 mph, with gusts as high as 25 mph.

Sunday night: Increasing clouds, with a low around 58°.

Winds will be South at 5 to 15 mph, shifting east in the night with possible gusts of 20 mph.

**Monday**: Mostly cloudy, with the temperature falling to near  $50^{\circ}$  in the afternoon.

Rain chances are 50% with N winds at 10-20 mph gusting to 25 mph.

**Monday Night**: Cloudy, with a low near 39° and a 40% chance of showers. Winds will be from the north at 15 gusting to 20 mph.

## Badgers Win Again! 36 – 18 over LBJ Austin



Possibly the team that appeared to be best positioned to threaten Lampasas' superiority in district football action just failed to do it last night. Though we did see the Jaguars pull ahead of Lampasas 18-17 for a short while in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter.

It was a chilly night for the faithful fans that managed to get some of the quickly sold out tickets to the game. They were certainly treated to another exciting win as the Badgers came off the  $3^{rd}$  quarter deficit to charge across goal line again and again in the remaining minutes.

Kudos to both offensive and defensive squads as they played some great football and earned for themselves, once again, a trip into the post season playoffs!

Next week the Badgers will be on the road at Fischer Canyon Lake. Canyon Lake is 4-4 overall and 2-1 in district after beating Fredericksburg last night 20-14. It was a close one with the teams swapping leads but Canyon Lake proved best in the end with their 8 point 4<sup>th</sup> quarter comeback. Fredericksburg was thought early-on to be a threat for the district lead this year but they have failed to meet expectations, 0-3 winless in district so far.

Lampasas will meet Fredericksburg in their last district game of the season on Nov. 6<sup>th</sup> in a home game.

Lampasas, looking at the numbers and records, earned itself at least a playoff berth last night. And it appears that the team, at least on paper, is heavily favored to win district. The pickers would all have Lampasas in the top 3 or 4 in state competition. Aren't we proud of our Badgers!

#### Badger Football continues to roll over

opponents, especially in the last half in the last couple of games. The scoring started in the Badger's first possession with a long pass to Lane Haviland and Jack Jerome punched it in a little at a time until a 2 yarder went in for the first TD. Ace Whitehead kicked the field goal and it was 7-0. LBJ came back a few minutes later with a long pass play that went for a TD but the conversion after failed. Early in the 2<sup>nd</sup> qtr LBJ came back again with another TD pass, but they went for the conversion again and failed again, leaving them ahead 12-7. With 5 minutes to go the Badgers got it going, Michael Murray had a 19 yard pass, Ace Whitehead went 15 yards and Case Brister did the same, going in for a TD. Ace then went on to kick the extra point and later a 37 yard field goal. The half finished 17-12 Lampasas.

In the second half, LBJ ran one in but failed to convert. Whitehead threw a 9 yard pass to Ethan Moreno for a TD but the conversion failed making it 23-18 as the game went into the  $4^{th}$  qtr.

Jack Jerome would go in again, this time on a rush for 7 yards. A PAT failed and it was 29-18.

Ace Whitehead would add the remaining points on the board, going in on a QB keeper and then kicking the extra point to make it 36-18.

The Badgers would have 354 yards total offense to LBJ's 304. The Badger yardage was heavily tilted toward the run this time with 257 on the ground and just 97 in the air. Ace Whitehead passed 18 times with just 7 completions, to Michael Murray, Ethan Moreno and Lane Haviland. All of the above showing that the LBJ team was studied and ready for the Badger passing game when they got to town.

Jack Jerome was the workhorse for the Badgers, carrying the ball 31 times for 120 yards and 2 TDs, just ahead of QB Ace Whitehead in the rushes as Ace ran 16 times for 82 yards and one TD. Ethan Moreno was also big in the game with the outstanding TD pass reception, and the same for Lane Haviland.
