The Weather



The High yesterday 82° The Low this morning 55°
.04 inches of rain was recorded at the airport.

The forecasters say that the drizzle-mist-fog will be with us most of the day, and into tonight. Some warming should occur on Tuesday, as the light rain and drizzle continue. Wednesday will be a bit warmer, with rain chances ending. The rest of the week is forecasted to be dry with highs in the 60's and 70's.

Today: Look for cloudy skies and falling temperatures today, a possible shower or storm around noon, then drizzle hanging around. The temperature is expected to be near 48° by 5pm today. Winds will be N near 15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy skies and a 70% chance the rain and drizzle will stick around through the night. The low temperature will be near 38°. Gusty winds will continue from the north near 15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Tuesday Cloudy with a 50% chance of drizzle and rain through the day and a high near 45°. The wind continues from the north near 15 mph with gusts up to 20 mph.

Commissioners' Court



The Lampasas County Commissioners Court held a regularly scheduled meeting this morning at 9am. The consent agenda was approved, as well as accounts payable and payroll.

A request for financial help from the Lampasas County Museum, that was tabled at the last meeting. Due to the pandemic museum contributions and operation funds are low. The museum was requesting \$5000, however \$1000 was approved by the commissioners for this year only. This request was brought to the court after the yearly budget had been approved.

The final plat for River Hills Subdivision phase III saw no action taken, as the plat does not meet city requirements.

There is no new report on the Jail Project. The next Jail Project meeting will take place on November 5th.

City Council



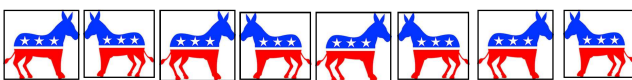
The Lampasas City Council has called a special session today at 5:30pm. Council will adjourn into executive session, then return to special session for discussion and possible action on items considered in executive

session. Council will then meet in a workshop session for items on the regular session agenda.

The Regular Session of the City Council will take place at 6pm. The agenda includes: citizen comments, and the consent agenda. Following that will be discussion/possible action on the 2nd reading of an ordinance granting the request to vacate an alley in block 54 of the AH Barnes addition by E. 9th St. & Spring Ho Ave. This will be conditional on the closing of the remaining lots in block 54, and providing all conditions for sale are approved by the people involved. Council will also hear the 2nd reading of the ordinance to prohibit pedestrian crossing 281S on foot, from 10th St. southward to the county line. Also included on the agenda; Board and Department reports, routine matters, the City Manager's Operational Report, to include W. 3rd Stl, the mail and the welcome sign. In new business, there will be discussion/possible action regarding the Chamber of Commerce 4th quarter report; a resolution terminating (*cont'd on back*)
