The high yesterday 54° This morning's low 41°
It's a bit blustery this morning, with Central Texas seeing some of the highest wind speeds in the state. Look for the clouds and the winds to decrease this afternoon with clear skies and light winds settling in. This will create a cool night that the forecasters say should fall into the 30's again. Tomorrow looks to be a pretty day with temperatures in the 60's and light winds. Look for a nice day Saturday as well, with high temperatures in the 60's and 70's.
Today: Mostly cloudy with gradual clearing and a high near 56°. Winds will be gusty from the N at 15-25 mph, with possible gusts of 35 mph.
Tonight: Clear skies and a low around 36°. Winds will be N-NW at 5-10 mph.
Friday: Patchy fog is possible in the morning, then sunny with a high near 64°. The wind will be light from the N-NW shifting E in the afternoon.
Overnight Friday: Partly cloudy with a low near 40°. Light E breezes will become S in the night.
Saturday: Mostly sunny with a high temperature near 71°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph.
Saturday night: Look for mostly cloudy skies and a low near 46°, with light S-SE winds shifting W after midnight

Coronavirus Update

The last report from Dr. Hay that was received at Lampasas Radio yesterday evening shows 413 total cases, 14 active cases, and 1 Lampasas County resident hospitalized. The State of Texas saw 5,175 new cases yesterday and 5,650 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.



The Lampasas ISD website has updated data for Covid-19 on a campus-by-campus basis. It shows as of yesterday; Hanna Springs Elementary with 0 active/2 recovered students and 0 active/3 recovered staff; Kline Whitis Elementary has 0 active/1 recovered student and 0 active/recovered staff; Taylor Creek Elementary has 0 active/recovered students and 0 active/1 recovered staff; Lampasas Middle School has 0 active/2 recovered students and 0 active/1 recovered staff; Lampasas High School has 2 Active/20 recovered students and 1 active /0 recovered staff. For other district staff LISD shows 0 active/4 recovered.

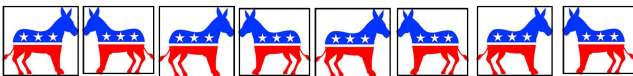
Early Voting

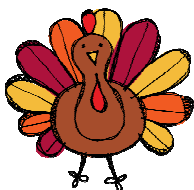
