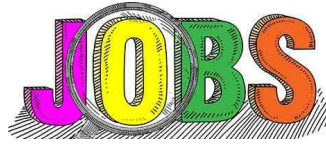

But if the solicitation includes an endorsement by the city, beware. It could be a scam."
