## Hunters' Edition 2019

### Opening Day Weather

**Saturday Morning** when the hunters make their way in to their stands. the low temperature will be near 37°, with a nice light breeze out of the north. Sunrise will be at 7:48am (remember to wait until 30 minutes before sunrise to take a deer), and the temperatures will be climbing into the 40's during the morning. For the evening hunt, the winds will shift to the northeast and stay near 5 mph. Sunset will be at 6:43pm. Remember to set your clocks back an hour when you get back to camp Saturday night. Sunrise Sunday will be at 6:49am, and the temperature will be near 38°, winds will be calm. Sounds like good huntin' weather....

### Things you need to know.....

#### Lampasas' Game Wardens are Shaun Bayless and Ray Milloway.

They are here to help, as much as to enforce our game laws. You can contact them anytime you need help or to report anything they need to know.

#### Important Rules Are:

- You have to have landowner's permission to take wildlife from their land. No roadside hunting is allowed in Texas. and

- You gotta' have a license, with the proper tags intact, along with the required hunter safety training.

#### What you can shoot

- You may only take 1 buck with a spread over 13 inches.
- You may not take a buck with a spread under 13 inches. How can you tell? Look at the deer from the front or back. The curve of the horn at its widest point must be outside the tip of the deer's ears.

#### If in doubt – don't shoot!

- You may also take 1 spike buck. This is a deer with at least one unbranched antler.
- You may also take up to 3 does or, if you take no bucks, you may take up to 5 does.

#### When you can shoot

- No sooner than 30 minutes before sunrise
- No later than 30 minutes after sunset

#### After you shoot a deer

- You must tag a buck's horn or a doe's ankle before you move the deer. You must completely fill out the tag.
- On MLD properties you must have the animal tagged soon after it is killed & before you begin to dress it.

# Big Buck Contest Update!

Lampasas Radio's Annual Big Buck Contest in partnership with Hoffpaur Ranch and Supply takes place this Saturday. Lampasas Radio will be broadcasting from Hoffpaur Ranch & Supply starting at 8am. The Trophy Scan will be utilized beginning at 9am to score the deer that are brought in.

The Lampasas Radio Big Buck Contest will have expanded hours for accepting deer, this year. You can bring in your properly tagged (whole deer harvested on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019) from 9am to 3pm to 1189 N Hwy 281 in Lampasas. (You're welcome all day but that is when Trophy Scan will be measuring). The contest has been opened up to any deer legally harvested and tagged in the State of Texas on **November 2nd**. (No MLD or Archery Harvests from days prior will be eligible).

Trophy Scan will be the official measuring judges and their one-of-a-kind technology is amazing! We have never had something this unique for a Deer contest in Lampasas. This system is used by the Los Cazadores store in Pearsall for their Big Buck Contest, the World's Largest Whitetail Deer Contest.

Along with our expanded hours, we have expanded categories for winning as well! However, contestants may only win one category, if they qualify to win a second category; it rolls to the next place in order to let more hunters win!

## Fort Hood to conduct prescribed Burn

Lampasas Radio received the following notice:

FORT HOOD, Texas -- The Directorate of Public Works Natural & Cultural Resources Management Branch along with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Balcones National Wildlife Refuge is conducting a prescribed burn operation beginning at noon Nov. 1 in live-fire training area 80 at Dalton Mountain here.

The burn is contingent upon weather conditions and is in conjunction with training a Soldier firefighting detail. LTA 80 is located between East Range Road and West Range Roads near the northern portion of the Installation. The burn will produce large quantities of smoke due to accumulated grasses, weeds, and brush. Fire & Emergency Services and the Directorate of Public Works will have adequate manpower and equipment on the scene to carry out the prescribed burn in a safe and efficient manner.
