In Lampasas County yesterday, 332 residents went to the polls for a total of 3118 votes cast in person. There were also 334 total mail-in ballots for a total of 3452 early votes.

In Lampasas, early voting is from 8am-5pm Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Today, November 1, early voting will be available from 7am to 7pm. All other days are 8am-5pm. The elections office is located at 407 S. Pecan St. #102 for those who want to vote early. The last day of early voting will be Friday November 4, 2022.



The School Bus Driver Shortage Affecting Fall School Activities

(Texas Tribune) Texas towns come to life on fall Friday nights when fans decked out in school colors fill stadiums to cheer on their high school football team. Marching bands, cheerleaders and drill teams ignite competitive spirits when decades-old rivalries kick off.

Across the state, school districts are improvising amid a national shortage of bus drivers. The issue is not new, school district officials said, but it has been exacerbated over the past few months by a labor crisis, fueled by such factors as the COVID-19 pandemic, child care challenges and a slowdown in immigration.

In a February 2022 national survey from the American Public Transportation Association, 71% of transit agencies reported that they've had to cut or delay service because of worker shortfalls.

Districts have tried to combat the driver shortage by raising pay rates for bus drivers and by holding job fairs.

The Tyler school district also pays for the training drivers are required to complete before taking the test for a commercial driver's license. Potential employees are hired as bus driver trainees at \$12 an hour and get their commercial learner's permit while taking the self-paced class. The class usually takes about two to three weeks to complete, according to the district's spokesperson, Jennifer Hines. Some district leaders said that new federal training requirements for bus drivers are excessive and make it too hard to hire new employees.

The U.S. Department of Transportation sets baseline training requirements for entry-level drivers. A new training requirement was put in place in February, requiring drivers to take a class before taking the CDL test for a permit. Those classes must be taken through an entity approved by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and can take two to three weeks and cost hundreds of dollars.
