## Texas Workforce Work Search Requirements

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) announced today that as the Texas economy continues to open TWC will reinstate state work search requirements, which had been suspended since March, but will resume on November 1, 2020. Work search is a federal requirement to receive unemployment benefits. Individuals will continue to receive benefits but must show an active effort to obtain new employment. A wide variety of activities qualify as a work search.

All individuals receiving unemployment benefits will need to complete the designated number of work searches, beginning on the date listed in their work search notification document. The work search notification document can be found in their correspondence inbox at [ui.texasworkforce.org](http://ui.texasworkforce.org) or U.S. Postal Mailbox. For example, individuals with an initial or additional claim the week of November 1<sup>st</sup> – work search activities would be effective the week beginning November 8th. For individuals with existing claims requesting payment the week of November 1<sup>st</sup>, work search activities would be effective the week beginning November 15.
