The Weather



The High yesterday 70° The Low this morning 49°

Today: Mostly sunny with a high near 78°. The wind will be southerly at 5-15 mph with gusts to 20.

Tonight: Clouds will come in and the wind should shift to northerly after midnight at 5-10 mph. The low should drop to 53° overnight.

Tuesday: The mostly cloudy skies will hang around, along with a noticeable north wind at 5-10 mph but that should shift to easterly in the afternoon. The high temp should get up to 72°.

Wednesday will be mostly cloudy with a high up to 74° and the wind will be back out of the south or at least SE Overnight there is a slight chance of a shower.

A change comes on Thursday as rain chances get up to 80%. The high should be a pleasant 67° but the wind will shift back to north at 5-10 mph in the afternoon as a front arrives. The rain chances continue overnight but should be gone for Friday's much cooler day.


Badger Sports Football
