Look for the sunshine to warm temperatures at least into the 70's, with areas west of 281 possibly reaching the 80° mark. Winds will remain SE near 10 mph today. Saturday look for another pretty day, with fairly light winds. The forecasters say the winds will increase on Sunday, with above seasonal temperatures.

Next week is expected to bring another cold front, with little chance for rain. The cool-down will not be impressive, but

temperatures should be near normal for November. **Today:** Mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 79°.
