## The Weather



**The High yesterday 75° The Low this morning 62°**

Forecasters are telling us that Central Texas will see one more warm day before a strong cold front brings widespread rainfall and a big cool down to the area. The cold front will be diving through the Northern Plains today and making its way through the Texas panhandle tonight. Showers and thunderstorms will usher in the cooler weather tomorrow, and all areas should receive some rain. Once you factor in the dropping temperatures, showers and strong winds, it should be a pretty blustery day.

**Today:** Cloudy with a high near 77° and S wind 5-15 mph.

**Tonight:** Cloudy with a low near 62°. S wind 5-10mph becoming light after midnight.

**Thursday:** Look for the temperature to top out near 65° by 9am, then falling into the mid 50's for the rest of the day. Wind will become N at 10-15 mph in the morning and could gust as high as 20 mph. There is an 80% chance of showers.

**Thursday Night:** There is a 30% chance of rain before midnight, then cloudy with a low near 40°. Winds will be N at 15 ph gusting as high as 25 mph.

**Friday:** Mostly cloudy with a high near 55° and a N wind at 5-15 mph.

**Texas voters went to the polls** yesterday to have their voices heard. While voters were supporting most changes to the Texas Constitution, they were opposing a measure that would allow elected municipal judges to work in more than one jurisdiction. That Proposition failed.

Supporters of one of the most contentious issues on the ballot — Proposition 4 — claimed victory within hours of the polls closing last night, with about three fourths of voters supporting the proposal in early voting returns. The proposition eliminates the possibility of Texas imposing an income tax unless the state

changes its constitution again.

Easily passing was funding for state parks and Prop 10, which had the highest level of support, amends the state constitution to allow retired service animals, such as dogs or horses, to be adopted by their handlers or other qualified caretakers. The animals are currently classified as surplus property or salvage and can be "auctioned, donated or destroyed."

Proposition 6, allowing for an increase of bonds allocated to the Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas. This proposition received nearly two-thirds support, according to unofficial results anyway.

Voters were also overwhelmingly in favor of Proposition 8 which would set aside \$800 million from the state's rainy day fund for flood mitigation efforts. The amendment was approved by the Legislature following Hurricane Harvey's devastation along the Texas coast. The proposition netted about three-fourths of the vote.

Another Harvey-related item, Proposition 3, also passed easily. The ballot initiative allows the Legislature to provide temporary tax breaks for people with property damaged in governor-declared disaster areas. The resolution and its legislation were approved by the Legislature unanimously earlier this year.
