The Weather



The High Yesterday: 76° The Low this Morning: 50°

After a pretty day today, we are forecast to have a mild night with SE winds. Temperatures will be in the upper 50's, and normal lows for this time of year are upper 40's. Tomorrow looks to be windy with clouds in the morning clearing in the afternoon. Winds could gust from the south at 25 mph. Next week shows a cool front moving through our area Monday night/Tuesday. Before the front will be humid and warm conditions. The cooler drier airmass will bring the area back to seasonable temperatures.

Today: Sunny skies and a high near 77°. Light SE wind at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Increasing clouds, with a low around 56°, with a light SE breeze.

Sunday: Mostly cloudy in the morning, clearing in the afternoon, with a high near 76°. South wind at 5 to 15 mph, with gusts as high as 25 mph.

Sunday night: Increasing clouds, with a low around 61°. Winds will be S-SE near 10 mph.

Monday: Partly sunny, with a high near 78°. Winds will be S at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Monday Night: Partly cloudy, with a low near 61°. Winds will be S-SE at 10-15 mph shifting SW in the night.

The Amazing Badgers

Won their second District Title in 2 years last night with an undefeated season, soundly defeating the Billies 56-20.

The Badgers had 4 rushing touchdowns, 2 from Ace (9 carries/88 yards) and 2 from Jack Jerome (15 carries 140 yards). Michael Murray had 4 receptions for 154 yards and 3 touchdowns.



Joseph Whitehead had 2 carries for 35 yards. The score was 42-zip at halftime, and the Billies came out of the locker-room ready to play. After gaining only 162 yards in the 1st half, Fredericksburg had 257 yards in the 2nd half for a total of 419 yards. (the Badgers put 292 yards up the 1st half, and 160 the 2nd half for a total of 452 yards.) The Billies scored 3 touchdowns in the 4th quarter, but were also plagued by 2 interceptions and a fumble for turnovers.

Looking Forward

Lampasas Radio confirmed with LISD Superintendent Dr. Rascoe that the Badgers will have their 1st playoff game this Thursday in Fredericksburg against the Uvalde Coyotes. We are the home team. Tickets will be available mid-week.

The Blotter

Click-it-or-Ticket is Back

From TxDot: One of the simplest and easiest precautions everyone can take to protect themselves and their loved ones: buckling up.

Wearing a seat belt reduces the risk of dying by 45% for people in the front seat of passenger cars. For those in pickups, seat belts reduce the risk of dying by 60% since pickups are more likely to roll over than passenger vehicles.

"Our annual *Click It or Ticket* campaign is about saving lives," said TxDOT Executive Director James Bass. "While almost 91% of Texans have gotten into the habit of using seat belts, there are still far too many motorists who are taking unnecessary chances by not buckling up. Whether you're the driver or a passenger, wearing a seat belt—day and night—is the single most effective way to protect yourself from serious injury or death in a crash." TxDOT officials report that in 2019 there were 925 traffic fatalities involving an unbuckled driver or passenger, a 6% drop over the previous year. Although around 9% of Texans do not wear a seat belt, the lack of seat belt usage was reported in 42% of traffic fatalities for those people who had the option to use a seat belt (excluding pedestrian, bicycle and motorcycle fatalities).

From November 16 to November 29, as we approach and celebrate Thanksgiving and more drivers take to the road, state troopers, police officers and sheriffs' deputies statewide will step up enforcement of the state's seat belt and child car seat laws. Texas law requires everyone in a vehicle to be properly secured in the front or back seat or face fines and fees up to \$200. Children younger than 8 years must be restrained in a child safety seat or booster seat unless they are taller than 4 feet 9 inches. If a child isn't secured, the driver faces fines of up to \$250.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the *Click It or Ticket* initiative in Texas is estimated to have saved more than 6,234 lives, prevented more than 100,000 serious injuries, and resulted in \$23.6 billion in economic savings since the campaign began in 2002.
