## General Election Tomorrow

While there is no presidential election this year, eligible Texans can cast their ballots for state leaders and their district-based representatives tomorrow.

The governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, comptroller, land commissioner and agriculture commissioner — who all serve four-year terms — are up for election.

Members of the state's Railroad Commission, which regulates oil and gas, and various state courts are up for election to six-year terms.

All U.S. representatives, state senators, state representatives and members of the State Board of Education are also up for election after the redrawing of political districts last year based on the 2020 census. U.S. and state representatives are elected to two-year terms while state senators and State Board of Education members draw lots to serve two- or four-year terms after the first post-redistricting election.

In our US House District, District 11, August Pfluger (R) is running unopposed. The Texas House District for our area, District 68 has David Spiller (R) running unopposed. Texas Senate District 24 for our region has Pete Flores (R) running against Kathy Jones-Hospod (D). The State Board of Education has 15 Districts and in our area, State Board of Education District 10, Tom Maynard (R) is running unchallenged.

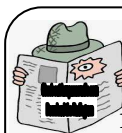

## The Blotter

**In Lampasas County** a total of 4,819 early votes were cast in person and 391 early votes were mailed in for a total of 5,210 votes for our county.

## Lampasas ISD School Board to Meet

**The Lampasas ISD Board of Trustees** will meet this evening for a regular school board meeting at 6pm at the Lampasas ISD administration building.

The agenda includes the consent agenda, to include a budget amendment, the quarterly and annual investment reports, and a public notice that Lampasas uses Internet Filtering. Also on the agenda is a list of bills, administrative reports, district and campus improvement plans, a campus report from Lampasas Middle School, a long term facility plan for Lampasas High School and possible consultation with an attorney regarding a Petition for Detachment and Annexation.

## School Safety Update

The Texas Education Agency announced Thursday a plethora of proposals that would, among other changes, require public schools to install silent panic alarms and automatic locks on exterior doors. Other proposals include inspecting doors on a weekly basis to make sure they lock and can be opened from the outside only with a key. Two-way emergency radios would also have to be tested regularly. Schools would need to add some sort of vestibules so visitors can wait before being let in, and all ground-level windows would have to be made with bulletproof glass.

These proposed requirements come about five months after a gunman killed 21 people, including 19 children, at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde. The gunman entered a door that had been closed by a teacher, but the automatic lock failed.

If approved, schools would have to start putting in place these safety measures starting in 2023. Before the end of this year, the education department will collect public comments on the proposed rules. The state has allocated \$400 million for increased safety measures that will be disbursed to districts. In the coming weeks, the education department will make a grant application available to districts. Districts will receive those grants based on enrollment, while smaller, rural schools will receive the minimum \$200,000. Proposing these safety measures is the latest action the state has taken to secure schools in the wake of the Uvalde shooting. In June, the education department announced that it would check all the locks on exterior doors prior to the start of the 2022-2023 school year and review every district's school safety plans.
