The Weather



High yesterday was 64° at 5:55am

The low this morning was 38°

Today: Cloudy with a high near 49° and a 20% chance of showers before noon. Wind will be N at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with a low near 36°, and N wind becoming calm. Patchy frost after 5am.

The weekend will be warmer as south winds return. Highs Saturday will be in the 60's, and Sunday may be cloudy but high temperatures are expected to reach the low 70's.

Things get blustery on Monday as a stronger cold front rolls through. The forecasters are still a little unsure of the timing, either early Monday morning or late Monday morning. The timing will have a big impact on our high temperatures Monday. The areas NW of us could see highs only in the 40's, while the areas to our SE could see highs in the 60's. Wind advisories may be issued for winds over 35 mph. Winds will continue to be strong overnight Monday with a widespread freeze expected Tuesday morning, with wind chills in the teens.

Saturday: Mostly sunny with a high near 67° light W breezes shifting S in the afternoon.

Saturday night: S-SW wind near 5 mph, and partly cloudy with a low near 46°.

Sunday: Partly sunny with a high near 72°

Overnight Mostly cloudy with a low near 52°,

The Lampasas Badgers football team 8-1/4-0 will travel to Fredericksburg to meet the 6-3/4-0 Billies.

The two teams are tied in district and the outcome of this last district game will determine the seeding as the teams go into the



playoffs. Lampasas is the top pick in the game with QB Ace Whitehead overwhelmingly the leading passer in the district with a 71% completion rate, 2300 yards and 29 touchdowns according to the MaxPreps Sports website. Interestingly enough, Fredericksburg's Tucker Elliott is number 2 with 1661 yards and 16 TDs.

Lampasas' Jack Jerome is the MaxPreps number 3 rusher with 896 yards, followed by Badger Daunte Cuffie at number 5 with 601 yards.

Fredericksburg's QB isn't afraid to run either, so far the number 6 rusher in the district, a bit ahead of Badger QB Whitehead who is the number 9 rusher.



In receiving, the top ten in district list has 4 Badgers and 4 Billies on it.

The defensive stats are perhaps more telling with the top 4 tackling stats belonging to Badgers Case Brister, Koby Allen, Daunte Cuffie and Keagan Richardson.

Of course all these stats may not mean anything when the two teams come together on a chilly night at 7:30pm in Battlin' Billie Stadium in Fredericksburg at 1107 TX-16.
