The Weather



The High yesterday 72° The Low this morning 51°

About this low temperature.... The temperature in Lampasas went from 68° at 10:35am to 51° at 10:55am.

Today: Cloudy, with the temperature climbing into the 60's before the incoming cold front hits. Winds will shift late this morning to become N at 20-25 mph gusting to 40 mph. The National Weather Service has issued a wind advisory until 6am tomorrow. The temperature will fall to near 41° today, with a wind chill expected at 5pm of 31°.

There is a slight chance of rain through the day.

In Abilene, Texas at press time the winds were sustained at 32 mph, gusting to 45 mph, and the temperature was 42°. In Amarillo it is now 22° with a wind chill of 2°.

Tonight: Areas of drizzle and sleet through midnight, then becoming partly cloudy with a low near 24°. The N winds will continue at 20-25 mph with gusts as high as 40 mph. Wind chill values will range between 9° and 19°.

Tuesday: Sunny with a high near 44°. Winds will be N at 15-20 mph, gusting to 25 mph, then decreasing to 5-10 mph in the afternoon. The wind chills will hover around 10°-20°.

Overnight Tuesday: A low of 22°, with N wind becoming calm.

Wednesday: A high near 54°, with S wind at 5-10 mph



Lampasas Badgers District Champs Headed to Bi-District on Friday

After a stunning victory that turned out just the way we expected, the Badgers beat a top notch Fredericksburg team by a decided, but sort of close, 47-35 score.

Now district champs, the Badgers have the number 1 seed in the Bi-district playoff and go up against the #4 team out of district 13, Brazosport.

This first playoff game will take place at Hays High School's Shelton Stadium. It is an artificial turf field and located at 4800 Jack Hays Trail in Buda, TX.

Brazosport so far this year:

The Brazosport Exporters (6-4/3-3) football team is coming off a high scoring 42-13 last game win. They seem to be a little better with the run than pass, scoring 23 times rushing this season and 15 times passing. There were 1653 yards gained rushing and 1220 passing in their 10 games to date.

The Exporters have two QBs. Senior A. Villareal threw the ball 56 times this year with a 60% completion rate, 521 yards and 5 TDs. Then there is freshman K. Goins who threw the ball 80 times with a 57% completion rate, but for 619 yards and 7 TDs...and was intercepted 3 times.

By far, their favorite receiver has been number 1, senior R. Bell, who caught the ball 33 times for 549 yards and 6 TDs, but also catching the ball a lot is another senior, number 4, E. Flores, who caught 20 passes for 263 yards.

Brazosport's most successful rusher has been #24, senior D. Preston. The ball has gone into his hands 40% of the time and he has carried it for 712 yards this season, even though he didn't play in one of their 10 games. He scored 8 of the teams 23 TDs this year. He also caught the ball and did runbacks for another 102 yards, giving him a total of 814 yards.

Lampasas so far this year:

Lampasas stats in the regular season included Ace Whitehead's outstanding passing records of 165 completions with a 70% completion rate, 2,625 yards and 35 TDs. On top of that he was the number 2 rusher with 442 yards and 13 TDs with the ball under his own arm.

That said, it was not a one man show this year.

Consider the receivers on the other end of Ace's throws. Sure handed and fleet-footed young men like Cameron Everts who caught 56 passes for 867 yards and 8 TDs, Jaylon Porter caught 44 for 785 yards and 11 TDs, Michael Murray, Jr. caught 34 passes for 651 yards and 12 TDs, Brenton Webb caught 22 for 233 yards and 4 TDs and Clayton Bever, who is most often seen as a defensive back and kick receiver, caught 5 for 76 yards and 1 TD. Add in Bever's other duties gives him a total of 601 yards in regular season.

Rushers, even for a passing team, are very important, and Lampasas a great corps here too. Jack Jerome has had a great year, totaling 942 yards on the ground with 10 TDs. Another player with a great year has been Duante Cuffie. Cuffie has been plagued with injuries for part of his high school career, but with a healthy season, he has racked up 614 yards and 8 TDs so far.

Altogether, the Badgers had 2352 yards rushing this year, almost matching the passing yardage.

The Badgers scored 522 points in their 10 games.

On defense, the Badgers have been stingy, giving up an average of only 19.3 points per game. Over and over again we have seen leading tacklers Case Brister, Kobe Allen, Daunte Cuffie and Keagan Richardson bringing down runners and charging into the backfield. Clayton Bever and others have been instrumental in pass defense for the Badgers.

Summing it up, Lampasas should be favored in this first playoff game. The Badgers were ranked last week in Dave Campbell's Texas Football as number 7 in 4A, Div. 1 and should go up a notch after Needville's loss and Lampasas' win.

We also note that Ace Whitehead is in the Mr. Texas Football Top 25 Semifinalist list. Also in that list is Sean O'Keefe of San Saba.
