Court Docket Call on November 5th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 51 cases were brought to the court with 46 cases involving men, and 5 cases involving women.

There were 16 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/ PG1. There were 10 cases for less than a gram, 4 cases for 1-4 grams, and 2 cases for 4-200 grams. There were 4 DWI cases. There were 4 tampering with evidence cases, three burglary cases, two cases for theft \$2500-\$30,000, and one case each for robbery, engaging in organized criminal activity, evading arrest, bail iumping/FTA felony, and credit debit card abuse.

There were 5 cases of assault on a family member, 2 for sex offenders failing to register, and aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. There was one case each for the following; aggravated assault/public servant, stalking, intoxication assault, harassment of a public servant. There was one case for aggravated sexual assault of a child, one case for sexual assault of a child and two cases for sexual assault.

Of the cases heard, 5 were settled with Ashley Willis receiving 3 years probation plus court costs and fines on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. Clay Navarette plead guilty to DWI w/ a child under 15 in the car and was sentenced to 1 year county jail, all probated, plus fines, court costs and an interlock device. Lane Cardenas plead guilty to engaging in organized criminal activity and was sentenced to 5 years probation plus costs and fines. Geronimo Romero plead guilty to assault on a family/household member and was sentenced to 7 years probation plus costs and fines. Patrick Boutelle, of San Marcos plead guilty to DWI 3rd or more and was sentenced to 6 years TDCJ, all probated, plus costs and fines.

The rest of the cases were reset or had dates set for jury trials.
