The forecasters say to look for highs in the 80's in Central Texas today. Overnight there is a cool front that will possibly bring a wind shift and some clouds. Tonight's lows will be in the lower 60's. Enjoy the nice weather, as a strong cold front is expected to move through by midday on Sunday bringing blustery north winds.

Today: Sunny with a high near 81°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph.

Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay reported this morning that Lampasas County now has 456 total cases, and 22 active cases. The State of Texas had 10,097 new cases reported and 6,779 Texans were hospitalized as of yesterday.

In the southern part of Texas, El Paso county had 970 additional confirmed cases yesterday, and 24,059 confirmed cases in the past 14 days. Governor Abbot is sending additional resources to the El Paso area, as well as the Lubbock area. These resources include medical personnel, medical equipment, personal protective equipment (PPE), mobile testing sites, and more.

Broadband Development in Texas

Last week, the Governor's Broadband Development Council submitted a report about broadband connectivity, or lack thereof, in Texas.

There are many challenges to broadband connectivity in rural and unserved areas of the state, and currently Texas is one of six states that does not have a statewide broadband plan. In studying the progress of broadband development in unserved areas, the Council found that over 300,000 locations in Texas are unserved. As of July 2020, an estimated 926,859 Texans do not have access to broadband at home.

The Council studied barriers to broadband development in Texas. Some of the main barriers identified include regulatory, economic, and technical factors. The Council studied practices and initiatives in other states as well.

Resulting from this research, the Council recommends that the Texas Legislature take the following action:

- *Create a state broadband plan; and
- *Establish a state broadband office.

The Council also believes that the following action could benefit the broadband landscape in Texas and therefore recommends its continued study:

- *Develop a state broadband funding program to incentivize deployment in unserved areas.

The future economic success of Texas communities, and the state in general, will likely be dependent on how Texas uses and expands access to broadband internet



Badgers are starting their playoff run tonight in Fredericksburg.



Here's the way it looks:

Lampasas is the number 1 team from Div. 1, Region 4, District 13 and opponent Uvalde is the number 4 team from District 14.

Uvalde is only 1-3 in their district while Lampasas is undefeated this year and rated as the number 2 team in the entire State Division. So, it looks good, barring some kind of disaster and upset, for the Badgers.

The Uvalde Coyotes should throw the ball a lot. Their QB, Donovan Davila is plenty capable. He has receivers #11 Christian Rivera and #1Estevan Ortiz and more that can catch 'em. Rushing possibilities include #3 Hunter Reimer and QB Davila himself, who looks a little like our Ace Whitehead in the ability to be pretty mobile.

As for the Badgers, they're all threatening on both sides of the ball. QB Ace Whitehead is one of the premiere passers in Texas football and long ball receiver Michael Murray has showed up over and over again. Rusher Jack Jerome continually runs through defenses and the list goes on through the entire squad.

If the Badgers win again tonight, they'll meet either La Feria or Miller, the teams from District 16 and 15. After that, the host of possibilities are Boerne, Burnet Zapata and Calhoun..

The only team that has given Lampasas any real trouble this year was LBJ Austin and people ask us about having to play them again. The answer is, not likely. But, if it did happen, it would be in a Regional Championship game that's 4-deep in the playoffs.

How 'bout them Badgers! Looking at the pundits and prognosticators, they are ranked as number 2 in the Texas Division 1 behind Argyle but ahead of La Vega.

Even better, we see them ranked as number 3 in the All Texas Poll, but that's only behind the big 6A teams of Dawson Pearland and Temple. It's all pretty heady stuff for our boys and we're hoping for a State Championship but whatever comes of it...Badger fans are sure proud!
