The Weather

The High yesterday 76° The Low this morning 56°



The forecasters say that a few showers may make it into our neck of the woods today on a cold front expected to stall in our area this evening. A nice day is on hand for tomorrow, and a strong cold front is expected to move through on Saturday night bringing the high temperatures for Sunday into the 60's.

Today: Partly sunny with a high near 73°, and light breezes from the east.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy and down to about 63° with a slight chance of showers overnight. Wind will become S at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Saturday: Cloudy in the morning, then the skies will clear to mostly sunny with a high temperature near 82°. Winds will be S-SW at 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

It's Friday!



TGIF! – For the first time in a while, it's not Football Friday – for the Badgers at least.

The Lampasas Badgers completely dominated the Uvalde Coyotes last night in Fredericksburg for the **Bi-District Championship, 61-14.**



It started off right for the Badgers. Uvalde kicked off, Cade White promptly took the ball 70 yards for a TD. Except for a first quarter tie at 7-7, and a last few minutes scoring drive by the Coyotes, it was a mismatch. Lampasas had 401 yards total offense, Uvalde 160.

Uvalde had suffered a tough season with one pre-district win and one district win, while the Badgers went into the playoffs with an undefeated season record.

Ace Whitehead threw 15 passes for the Badgers and completed 14 of them, picking up 207 yards and 3 TDs. Catching those passes were Ethan Moreno with 7 catches for 110 yards and 1 TD. Michael Murray caught 5 for 55 yards and a TD. Carter Johnson caught 2 for 43 yards and a TD.

Jack Jerome had 2 TDs for his 13 carries and 113 yard game. Case Brister was huge on defense with a 17 yard fumble return for a TD and a blocked punt for a safety.

Many of the starters left the field for the 2nd half and we saw relief QB Payton Underwood on the field. He ran for 27 yards and a TD in the 3rd period after Case Brister spent some time rushing for useful yardage. Joseph Whitehead was on offense, racking up yards and kicking PATS and a field goal. The Badgers will head to the next level of the playoffs against either Corpus Christi Miller or La Feria. That depends on which of those two teams comes out on top tonight when they play in Corpus.


