## The Badgers Enter the UIL Playoffs Tonight vs Brazosport on Buda's Hays High Field Gametime is 7:30pm – Tickets are online or at the gate.

The Lampasas Badgers football team 9-1/5-0 will travel to Hays High's Shelton Stadium today. The team is scheduled to load on the bus at Lampasas High at 3:20 pm with a send-off planned by the Badger Booster club. Fans are urged to see the team off at the parking lot about 3:30pm, or along the roadways as they leave town. They will head away from the school on Hwy 281 about 3:35pm, then on to Hwy 183S for the trip. The Badgers are favored in the contest tonight, having only one loss in their 10 game season, and that one to Lorena by a close 30-31 score. Brazosport has a 6-4 season record, 3-3 in district. The Exporters are somewhat



more inclined to run the ball than to pass, while the Badger's passing attack is one of the most formidable in state 4A football. It should be an interesting game.

With a 7:30pm kickoff and Austin traffic to contend with, fans that expect to eat out before the game should be leaving town shortly after the Badger bus. Some may elect to avoid the Austin traffic by taking an alternate route down 281S to Buda. If the Badgers win this Bi-district game tonight, they will either play Gonzales or Grulla in the next round. If they lose, of course the season would be over, but no Badger fan expects anything but a victory celebration at the end of tonight's game. The Badgers moved up a notch in Dave Campbell's Texas Football poll this week, from number 7 to number 6 in the Division I-4A section.

Attorney General Ken Paxton today warned Texans about reported scam callers falsely claiming to be members of the OAG's Crime Victim Services Division and attempting to obtain personal and financial information from members of the public.

The fraudulent callers are attempting to obtain personal identifying information from the call recipient and ask for money transfers or bank details after baselessly claiming the call recipient's social security number has been compromised. The callers are using local numbers and sometimes provide a false "case number" during the call. The true OAG Crime Victim Services phone number is toll-free 800-983-9933 and local number 512-936-1200. The OAG warns Texans against providing any personal

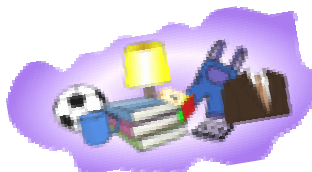

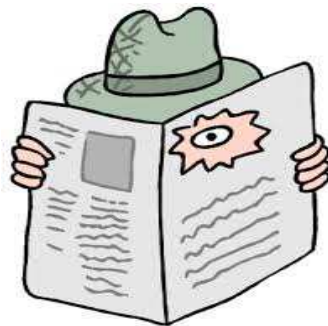
