The Weather

Burn Ban Lifted

Lampasas County Judge Randy Hoyer has lifted the burn ban through Monday, November 28th, 2022.

Commissioners Court

A Commissioner's Court meeting was held on Monday morning to discuss the monthly EMS report, end of year budget amendments, and county Christmas decorations. The EMS report shows a 5m 26s average response time within the city and a 12m 7s average within the entire county. The report also shows an increase in calls from 8/day on average to around 16-17/day. Commissioner Bobby Carroll expressed gratitude for the EMS service and their work. Two year-end budget amendments of \$17,600 & \$37,000 were briefly discussed and passed unanimously. An agreement to establish ownership and liability in case of damages or theft of the county courthouse outdoor decorations was passed and will allow for the routine decoration of the county courthouse and Downtown Square for the holidays.

Lampasas City Council

A City Council meeting was held on Monday evening to discuss the operational report, Business Park, Hancock Park golf course fees, and appointment of board members, among other items. The operational report includes the EMS Service report which indicates a positive start for Hamilton with "praise for the City's dispatch service." Training with the City of Lampasas Fire Department was conducted in the past month. Additional training with volunteer fire departments will begin this month. TxDOT (Brownwood district) will conduct a 2nd public open house on the feasibility of a relief route around Lampasas on November 17th, 2022 at the Middle School, 902 South Broad, from 5:30pm to 7:30pm. The report shows H&H Tree Service is on track to have Brook Park lit by Thanksgiving. All lights and displays are scheduled to be up for testing by November 13th. Seasonal lighting will begin the day

before Thanksgiving, November 23rd. Increased rainfall has slowed the final pad work for the Skate Park. Staff is hopeful the project can go vertical by year end. A motion to approve the final and preliminary Lampasas Business Park Subdivision Plat of 151.638 acres of land out of the Daniel Stanley Survey was passed. A motion to increase weekday, weekend, and 6-month membership fees for the Hancock Park Golf Course was passed. Weekdays will increase from \$34 to \$39. Weekends will increase from \$39 to \$44. A motion to reappoint board members, D'Anne Willis and Ruth Martin, to the Library Advisory Board was passed. Additionally, a motion to appoint Eric Hernandez to the Zoning Board of Adjustments was passed.

Lometa ISD School Board to Meet

The Lometa ISD will hold a regularly scheduled School Board Meeting on November 17th at 6:30pm in the Lometa School Library.

The agenda includes student and staff recognition, community input, consideration of the renewal of the Lometa ISD District of Innovation Plan for the 5 year term of January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2027, discussion of proposed Lometa ISD advanced technical center (vocational center) and financing options, the monthly investment report, consideration of budget amendments, administrative and personnel reports.

Holiday Drinking and Driving

Six years have passed since a drunk driver killed Azeza Salama's fiancé and sent her and her two children to the hospital, but her memories of the crash remain as vivid as the day it happened. As people celebrate the holidays with friends and family, TxDOT wants stories such as Azeza's to remind everyone to always find a sober ride.

Last year, Texas saw 48,641 traffic crashes during the holiday season—Dec. 1, 2021, through Jan. 1, 2022—which resulted in 433 fatalities and 1,695 serious injuries. Almost a quarter of those deaths—23%— were DUI-alcohol related with 98 people killed and 236 seriously injured in drunk driving crashes.

"With everything going on in the world these past few years, we want everyone to be able to celebrate this joyous time of year without the tragic consequences of drinking and driving," said TxDOT Executive Director Marc Williams. "Get together with family and friends and have a great time, but please find an alternative way home if you choose to drink. You have many options available."

Drunk driving crashes can be easily prevented, yet they can have serious physical, emotional and financial consequences that can last for years. Designate a sober driver, call a taxi, use a rideshare service, stay put, call a friend or family member, or use public transportation to ensure you get home safely if you decide to drink. 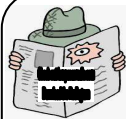
