The Weather



The High yesterday 65° The Low this morning 33°

It was quite chilly this morning, with pockets of frost and a few places at or below freezing. However, today should warm quickly under sunny skies to the low 70's. Tonight should be cool again with radiational cooling, and more places could reach the freezing mark tomorrow morning. Temperatures tomorrow should be in the 70's as well. The rest of the week should be warm and quiet with southerly winds.

Today: Sunny with a high temperature near 70°. Winds will be light from the SE.

Tonight: Look for mostly clear skies with a low temperature near 39°. Winds will become calm.

Tuesday: Sunny with a high temperature near 72°. The wind will be light from the E in the afternoon.

Tuesday Night: Mostly clear skies with low near 42°. Light E-SE wind will become calm.

Wednesday: Sunny with a high near 75°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph in the afternoon.

Wednesday Night: Mostly clear with a low near 52°, and light breezes from the S-SE.

Lampasas Radio has learned from Lt. Montgomery at the Lampasas Police Dept. that they were involved in a pursuit that began at 3:30am

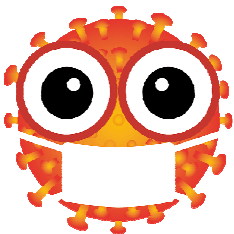
