Lampasas Game Warden Fired On – Manhunt Begins

A release finally came in late Thursday on a manhunt that took place on Wednesday afternoon. According to the release, on Wednesday, just after noon, Texas game Wardens Shaun Bayless



and Brent Whitus were dispatched to a criminal trespass call at the 300 block of FM 3270 in the Kempner area.

On arrival the complainant said that two occupants of a white pickup truck were trying to exit his property and a fence had been cut. The Game Wardens later spotted the pickup and pulled it over in the 5000 block of FM3270, but

as they approached the vehicle, it took off again.

A high speed chase began that led to a residence in the 2500 block of Big Divide Road. There the men exited the pickup and began to flee on foot. The passenger, identified as Johnnie Heintzman of Copperas Cove, was caught and placed in handcuffs.

The driver ran behind a house and when Game Warden Whitus pursued him on foot, the subject was seen to point a handgun and

fire in the direction of Whitus, then climb a fence and run into a thick cedar brush area. Neither of the Game Wardens were injured. The fugitive was identified as Robert Westly Morris of Lampasas, a W/M approximately 40 yrs of age.

Other officers were summoned and soon, agencies from the Sheriff's Office, DPS, Copperas Cove PD, Kempner and Lampasas PD, and Texas Dept. of Justice Canine team arrived. A DPS Fixed Wing Aircraft was brought in and a Red Code Alert was activated for residents in the area. Some residents were told to keep people and pets inside to keep them away from the Search Dogs. The search for the fugitive continued until dark with no success and was called off.

The captured man, Johnnie Heintzman, was booked into Lampasas Co. Jail and charged with criminal mischief for destroying a livestock fence, while multiple felony warrants for the fugitive,

Robert Westly Morris, (right) of Lampasas were issued. The charges include attempted aggravated assault on a police officer and unlawful possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.

Morris has a long record as a convicted drug manufacturer and dealer that goes back several years. He has been charged many times over the past several years and was most recently paroled early on a 20 yr sentence. The Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. and Copperas Cove Police Dept. are asking anyone who has possible information on the whereabouts of Morris to contact them immediately.


