

Lady Badgers Basketball 5/0 could be in for some real challenges this year. Our girls are in a 5 way tie for 10th place in the TGCA State 4A Coaches Poll. The berth is shared with Celina, Bandera, Glen Rose and Athens.

Up at the top of the list we see Canyon, Hardin-Jefferson, Fredericksburg and Taylor, in that order.

Of course the district has changed for this year and Lampasas is not in the district with any of those top four. Lampasas now shares a district with Glen Rose, Brownwood, Stephenville and Gatesville. Glen Rose is the only team mentioned in the early season Coaches Poll, and that is tied for #10 with Lampasas.

In the few games played so far Lampasas, Glen Rose and Stephenville are undefeated. Brownwood is 2-2 and Gatesville has only played 2 games and lost both of those.

We go on to another poll, which is completely different. It sees Lampasas way down the list as the number 20 team in 4A and Glen Rose is #2 behind Brownsboro. Stephenville is moved in and up to #4, etc.

This early in the season the guesses are pretty wide ranging. Glen Rose, however, is a good bet to go far this year. They're high in anybody's poll, and they went way into the playoffs last year, losing in the Regional Quarterfinals to Argyle. Glen Rose will be tested against #8 Midlothian on Tuesday.

Last night, Lampasas beat Austin Crockett 67-38. Crockett is a 5A team. Before that, in our girls' previous game, against 6A Killeen, the competition was a little stiffer. Lampasas jumped out front 16-7 in the first quarter. After that, Killeen outscored
