The Weather



High yesterday was 74° Low this morning was 46°

A colder and brisk morning is on hand for those headed out this morning as the cold front races southward through Central Texas. Temperatures saw most of the daily highs met this morning and in Central Texas will fall slowly through the day. Definitely a day to layer up. Look for temperatures to dip into the mid-30's Saturday morning.

Playoffs tonight vs Gonzales

Fans plan a big sendoff! The local booster club urges fans to either come to the high school area about 3:30-3:45pm or find a spot on the roadway between the school and Hwy 183. Bring noisemakers, signs, Badger gear or whatever you have to cheer on the team.

The team bus will leave the school parking lot at 4:15pm and turn left on Hwy 281, travel back toward town, and then on to Hwy 183S on the way to Pflugerville.

Gametime is 7:30pm – Tickets are online or at the gate.

The Pflugerville Pfield (the P is silent in both words) is a big, 10,000 seat, artificial turf field used by several area schools. It does have security rules! You may not bring a purse, camera case, backpack, etc. You can only bring a clear, see-thru, bag. It cannot be longer or wider than 12 inches and not thicker than 6 inches. A small handbag, no larger than the size of a hand, is allowed.

The ticket booth will be open at 6pm. Tickets are \$6 for students and \$8 for adults. Kickoff is at 7:30pm. Lampasas is the "Home" team and fans must sit on the Home side.

Lampasas will be up against a much stronger team this week than last. The Gonzales Apaches are 8-2 this year with their one district

loss being to Beeville Jones where they suffered a 27-3 waxing. Jones is a strong, unbeaten team so far.

All of that said, statistics seem to favor the Badgers. Our guys are rated the #84 team in the Maxpreps rankings and Gonzales is #368. The Badgers are ahead of the Apaches in almost every category, though they do have one scary feature... they have a running quarterback in Heath Henke, #23. Henke is listed as a 185 lb, 6ft QB who doesn't throw a lot, but has a 50%-plus completion rate. He runs a lot, leading the team in number of carries and in total yards, with well over a thousand yards so far this season.

Badger defenders may have their hands full with Henke. On the other hand, the Apaches have a double threat in the Badgers' Ace Whitehead. Ace is one of the best passing QBs in 4A football, and with his several excellent receivers and running backs, the team is a threat on the ground and in the air.

It should be a great game. Go Badgers!

For those who can't make the game, it will be broadcast over KCYL 1450 Sports Radio and live streamed on lampasasradio.com at the listen live site. KCYL's Darrell Brooks and Kenny Murray will be on hand and doing the play by play calling.


