Monday Meetings

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court met this morning for a regular meeting in the Commissioners Courtroom at the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The agenda included the consent agenda, accounts payable and payroll, a fireworks order, and an office lease agreement between Lampasas County and Texas Parks and Wildlife, the Acadian quarterly report and the burn ban. The remodel work in the JP #1, Treasurer and District Clerk's office will be discussed as well as some business with the Shooting Star Ranch LLC Subdivision and the definition of "occupancy" as found on page 20 of the Lampasas County Subdivision Rules and Regulations from 2015. This morning at 10am the Lampasas County Commissioners held a called meeting in the 1st Floor Conference room at the County Annex. The agenda included Lampasas

county Justices of the Peace and Constable Precinct redistricting and Lampasas County Election Precinct Redistricting.

The Lampasas City Council will meet today for regular meetings beginning at 5:30pm.

The Workshop Session agenda includes a Covid 19 update, discussion regarding the Council Work Session Agenda, Fire Dept. incident reporting and billing, and fencing and improvements to Hanna Springs at Campbell Park.

The Regular session will begin at 6pm and the agenda includes a public hearing to receive citizen comments about a request to close, abandon or vacate and convey the alley in Block 76, Lampasas Springs Company first addition. Also included will be the consent agenda, and discussion and possible action about adding fees related to Wi-Fi device lending. There will be departmental reports, routine matters, the City Manager's operational report to include discussion about the Georgetown tank and Christmas Events. Council will go into Executive Session concerning some economic development negotiations then return to regular session for action concerning the executive session.

Covid Booster Shots

Federal regulators on Friday authorized Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna coronavirus vaccine boosters for all adults on Friday, a one-size-fits-all strategy designed to shore up Americans' defenses against a tenacious virus and reduce confusion over guidelines that have varied based on people's age, occupation and where they live.

The Food and Drug Administration cleared the boosters for people 18 and older who are at least six months past their second shot of the two-dose vaccines. The move reflects an urgent effort to spur the uptake of boosters to counter waning vaccine protection heading into the winter holiday season when millions of people travel to see friends and family. It's also an attempt to put in place a coherent federal approach as about a dozen states move ahead on their own to grant broad access to boosters.

give advice on how the boosters should be used. Several have expressed reservations in the past about recommending the shots for healthy young men because of a rare cardiac side effect, but all have stressed the need for greater simplicity in vaccine guidelines. After getting the recommendations, CDC Director Rochelle Walensky was expected to sign off on broader use of boosters, also on Friday.

The new federal approach, many experts note, essentially ratifies what has been occurring on the ground; most people who have sought the shots have gotten them simply by telling pharmacists they are eligible. Even so, only about 37 percent of fully vaccinated people over 65, and 17 percent of all adults have gotten boosters, according to the CDC.
