## The Weather



**The High yesterday 84° The Low this morning 67°**

A Pacific cold front is expected to come through Central Texas during the early morning hours tomorrow. Showers should be short-lived. Cold air will then overtake the region with temperatures falling into the 30's and 40's.

An even colder air mass is expected for the end of the holiday weekend, and the drier air will help drop the lows into the 30's and 40's again Sunday morning, with highs only in the 50's. Monday morning should see lows in the upper 20's and 30's area wide.

**Today:** Mostly cloudy with a high near 82° and SW wind 10-15 mph.

**Tonight:** A low near 45° with partly cloudy skies. S-SW wind at 5-10 mph becoming N after midnight.

**Wednesday:** Partly sunny with a high near 55°. Wind will be N at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph. A 20% chance of showers and storms after 1pm.

**Wednesday Night:** Mostly cloudy with a low near 44° and a 40% chance of showers and storms mainly after 3am. NE wind near 10 mph.

**Thanksgiving:** Cloudy with a high near 58°, and a 70% chance of showers and storms. E wind 5-10 mph.

**Thanksgiving Night:** Showers likely and a possible storm. Cloudy with temperatures falling to near 57° by 9pm, then rebounding a little during the night. E-SE wind 5-10 mph.

**Friday:** A 50% chance of showers and storms with cloudy skies and a high near 75°. S wind at 10-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

## Commissioners Notes

**The Lampasas County Commissioners met** yesterday at 9am in the County Courthouse for a regularly scheduled meeting. The following items were discussed and/or approved:

A request from Kempner Water's Rodney Seaver was approved to make two road bores in the 5000 block of CR 3300. The bores will be 36" below the road.

There was discussion to amend the County Utility Installation Permit procedures. It was suggested to give the Commissioners authority to approve roadwork in their precinct. Then they would not have to bring it to Commissioners court. It was decided to discuss this at the next meeting.

A Participating Service Agreement was approved for the Statewide Victim Notification Services. This allows victims of a crime to go online and track the inmate and receive notifications when the inmate is transferred or released. There is no expense to the county. This is funded through the Texas Attorney General.

Level One Technology presented a bid in the amount of \$9,743 for additional and upgraded security cameras for the County Courthouse. The bid included replacing the cameras on the corners of the Courthouse with 290°, multi-lens cameras. The new cameras will allow greater visibility of the Courthouse and adjacent parking areas. The funding is from the Courthouse Security Fund.

## Lampasas City Council



The Lampasas City Council met yesterday evening in the City Council Chambers for a regularly scheduled meeting. Items covered in the meeting included:

Rickie Roy from the Public Works Dept. gave his monthly report. Mr. Roy stated that the workers in his department have installed over 1,500 feet of underground pipe this year. Misti Talbert stated at the meeting, "I have received more excellent comments on public works this year than I have in the past 4 years. Keep doing what you are doing."

Finley deGraffenried then gave his operational report. He spoke about the Annual Community Lunch and Toy Drive. This will be on December 9<sup>th</sup> this year from 11-2 at the Fire Station. This event serves lunch to over 500 people in the community and provides toys to over 175 families in the Lampasas area.

The City Manager mentioned that City Staff is meeting with contractors today to discuss the sidewalk plans for the Library Park Project. The project is slated to include walls, sitting areas, landscaping and artwork.

The City Council Meeting scheduled for December 23<sup>rd</sup> has been cancelled due to the Holiday

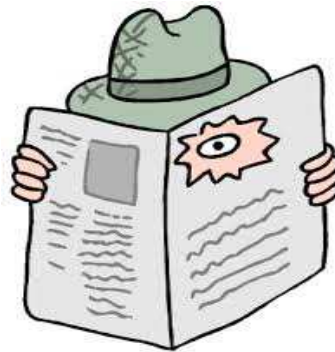
