#### Coronavirus Update

Statewide, on November 24th, there were 3316 new and 852 probable cases, along with 2,681 in the hospital. There were 80 deaths from Covid reported as well. Locally, in the last 14 days, Lampasas has seen 25 confirmed cases according to the DSHS website, with 5 being confirmed Wednesday. The state estimate is 35 active cases in Lampasas County.



#### Traffic Counts in our Area

Beginning November 29 through December 9, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will be collecting data in many locations throughout the nine county Brownwood District. TxDOT's Transportation Planning and Programming Division collects on average 80,000 short-term traffic counts throughout the state on an annual basis. This is achieved by the collection of 24 hour, short-term, counts at select locations (Interstate Highways, US Highways, FM roads, etc.) within the districts by contractor personnel. Traffic count data is then analyzed and adjusted to create an AADT (Average Annual Daily Traffic), one of the many products produced from traffic count data. These short-term counts are collected to support federal, state, regional, and local transportation projects and activities including: design, maintenance, safety, planning, and roadway performance as just a few examples. Traffic count data are required as part of the annual HPMS (Highway Performance Monitoring System) submittal process to the Federal Highway Administration.

The Brownwood District consists of nine counties: Brown, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, Lampasas, McCulloch, Mills, San Saba and Stephens Counties.

#### **Keeping Your Home Safe**

As many families travel and take time off from their busy lives to enjoy Thanksgiving with loved ones, local police officers continue to work to keep burglars away from the homes of those traveling out of town.



If you are on the road this week, you may want to let police or a close friend know. Many police officers recommend *not posting it on social media*. According to a post by the Lampasas Police Dept., it's like leaving your front door open.

Programs are in place to give police a heads-up and they can check in on homes while you are out. Local police departments anticipate a lot more travelers and want to offer assistance to as many people as possible.

But if you are more comfortable with friends watching over your property, police say deterring burglars can be simple.

One recommendation is to leave some lights on as if you were home, or rotating vehicles in the driveway to make it look like people are coming and going.

With holiday shopping starting soon after Thanksgiving, there are a lot more targets out there. Don't put boxes on the side of the street, break them down. You don't want people to know what you have in your house. I like to say, 'tis the season," said Leach. "Unfortunately, it brings the worst out in some people."
