The Weather



High yesterday was 48° Low this morning was 46°

Today: The drizzle and fog will continue until around noon, then there is a 50% chance of showers and storms after noon. Otherwise, cloudy with a high near 72°. Wind will become S-SE at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph. Precipitation coverage will decrease as the front pulls away this afternoon.

Tonight: Cloudy with a low near 64°, and a 30% chance of showers and storms after midnight. SE wind near 15 mph with gusts as high as 25 mph.

Saturday: A 40% chance of showers and storms before noon with mostly cloudy skies. Skies will clear in the afternoon with a high near 75°. Winds will become W-NW in the morning at 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Saturday night: W-NW wind at 5-10 mph with clear skies and 42°.

Sunday: sunny with a high temperature near 62° and NW winds at 10-15 mph. Sunday will be cooler than Saturday with gusty NW winds. Winds will subside Sunday night and with clear skies and low humidity Monday morning will be chilly with the 30's expected regionwide. It winds become calm in the western zone, some areas could dip into the 20's.

Overnight: Clear and 36°, N-NW wind continues at 5 mph.

Monday: High near 63° and N-NW wind near 5 mph becoming E in the afternoon.
