## Carol of Lights 2021

**The Carol of Lights officially kicks off the Holiday Season** in Lampasas this Saturday. This year's theme is "Blessings from the Heart of Texas"

The day gets going early with the farmers market from 8am-3pm on the east side of the square. 9am will find the classic cars 'Classics at the Classic' on the south side of the square until 4pm. There will be food trucks available from 10am – 8pm on the square as well. The Lampasas County museum will be open from 10am-7pm with the Christmas Tree Display contest and the Gingerbread House Contest, and a bake sale from 2-7pm. The annual Snow Queen Pageant will take place at 1pm on the bandstand, then at 5:30pm community groups will sing Christmas Carols. 6pm brings the Lampasas High School Flames program followed by the official Carol of Lights Lighting Ceremony at the bandstand. The Ajinomoto Foods Holidazzle Lighted Christmas Parade begins at 6:30pm with Robert Lu as the Grand Marshal, and the parade being announced and broadcast on 101.9fm KACQ.

Children's activities scheduled for the day include Santa Claus in the Ajinomoto Foods lobby at 601 E. 3<sup>rd</sup> St. from 3:30-6pm. Mask required and social distancing. Mrs. Santa's house will be open at the corner of 3<sup>rd</sup> and Western in the old Manuel Hardware building. There will be storytelling by Mrs. Claus at that location at 3:30 and 4:30pm, and from 4-4:30 there will be Christmas Crafts all brought to you by the Lampasas Public Library and LAFTA.

First Texas Bank on the square will have their Cup o' Corn from 4-5:30pm.

## The Omicron Covid

An article from KWTX tell us that the "World Health Organization warned Monday that the global risk from the omicron variant is "very high" based on early evidence, but local health officials told News 10 it's too early to know much about the new COVID-19 variant.

"We don't know how dangerous it really is, so there's a lot of unknowns right now," said Kelly Craine, with the Waco-McLennan County Health District.

Although the variant hasn't been detected in the United States, travel bans have been put in place for some African countries.

President Joe Biden on Monday said he'll wait to issue any more travel bans until he knows more about how dangerous the variant is.

Dr. Anthony Fauci, the president's chief medical adviser, said everyone coming into the country is already getting tested. "Fortunately, the PCR's that we use already pick up this very unique variant," said Fauci.

In Central Texas, health officials said they won't test for the specific variant and that the Texas Department of State Health Services will handle it state wide.

Dr. Marc Elieson with Baylor Scott and White said their care won't change based on the new variant.

"The variant type doesn't affect treatment or prognosis," Elieson said.

He adds that they'll wait to bring in more resources until they know the variant is a threat to Central Texas.

As they wait to learn more, health officials are all urging the same message: get vaccinated.

"Right now, get vaccinated, if you haven't gotten your booster yet, get your booster," Kelly Craine urged.

## The Blotter

There was a minor accident in the 500 block of E. 3<sup>rd</sup> St. at 4:33pm and a suspicious vehicle reported in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss Dr. at 11:02pm.

**The Sheriff's Dept. Blotter** for Monday shows Lometa with an assault. Kempner had medical calls, and out in the county there was an accident, animal issues, a reported runaway, a medical call, civil matters, a suicidal person and reports of suspicious activity.

**The Jail Log** shows the arrest of 22 year old Fabricio Bienbenu on a commitment charge and 25 year old Camry Brown of Ft. Worth on a probation violation and bail jumping/ failure to appear.

All brands must be reregistered in the county clerk's office beginning Aug. 31 2021 and you can register brands until February 28, 2022.

Pursuant to Texas Agriculture Code Section 144.044, every 10 years, all livestock and horse brands throughout the state expire. The current registrations expired Aug 31, and will require action before the end of February.

If a livestock owner uses brands, earmarks, tattoos or electronic devices to mark their cattle, hogs, sheep, goats or horses, they must register the brands with the county clerk, said Tiffany Dowell Lashmet, Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service agricultural law specialist, Amarillo.

"This is an important detail for brand holders not to overlook," Lashmet said.

Head to the county clerk's office

All livestock brands must be registered at the county clerk's office in every county where the owner has livestock, according to Texas Agriculture Code. The registration will require identifying the brand itself, along with the location where the brand or other identifying information is placed on the animal.

## Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 2036 new and 915 probable new cases on November 29th, along with 5 deaths. There were also 2,796 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 13 new confirmed cases in Lampasas County on November 29th, and 37 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The state estimates Lampasas County to have 48 active cases at this time.
