Food trucks will be available from 10am-8pm. The Lampasas County Museum at 303 S. Western will be displaying Christmas Trees from the Christmas Tree Contest and the Gingerbread Houses from the Gingerbread House Contest from 10am-6pm.

At 1pm the Snow Queen Pageant will take place at the bandstand. Santa will be in the Ajinomoto Foods lobby from 3:30-6pm, and the Lampasas Public Library will be hosting Mrs. Santa Storytelling and Christmas Crafts in the Manuel Hardware Building from 3:30-4:30pm. First Texas Bank will be having their Cup o' Corn from 4:30-6:30pm. From 5:30pm-6pm there will be caroling at the bandstand. 6pm brings the official Carol of Lights Lighting Ceremony along with a performance from the Lampasas High School Flames.

The Holiday Lighted Christmas Parade brought to you by Anjimoto Foods will begin at 6:30pm. The Grand Marshal this year will be the City Parks Department, and our own Ronnie Witcher will be the emcee for the parade.

Sunday December 4th brings the Annual Lampasas County Museum Tour of Homes from 1-5pm. Admission is \$10 with tickets available at the Lampasas County Museum.

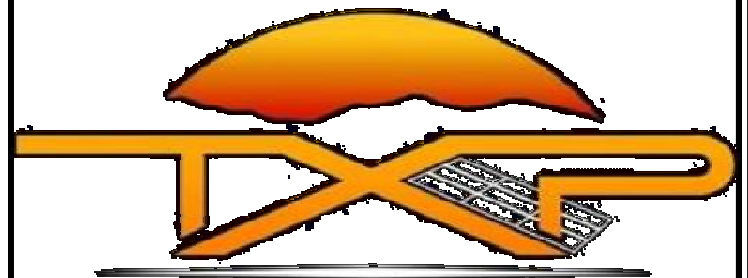
