Carol of Lights



The 88th Legislative Session

The Gavel drops on the 88th Legislative Session on January 10th. To date, approximately 900 bills have been filed, but most have a small chance of making it to a committee.

It's a long list of bills that Texas legislators will have to work through. Most of the bills will not even be heard, said political science professor Brandon Rottinghaus with the University of Houston. The Texas surplus is one pressing issue and how it can help property owners seeing their property taxes going up.

Rottinghaus, a political science professor at the University of Houston, offers that "The biggest thing the legislature is going to do is decide how to spend about \$29 Billion in surplus. The likely scenario is that it will go to tax cuts."

Another pressing issue is the Texas Electric Grid System and what improvements are being made on the system. "The state has to be

absolutely sure the grid is going to hold because so many businesses and families are relocating to Texas." He feels there will be legislation to try and improve the grid.

Another bill that has the possibility of making it to the floor is sports betting.

The Legislative Session runs 140 days from January 10th to May 29th.
